## Notification

Subject: Implementation of e-kuber system of RBI for Electronic disbursement of Government payment.

In accordance with series of initiatives taken by the state Government to ease the government business and improve transparency and efficiency. It has been decided to implement electronic payment system of RBI by integrating eKuber with IFMIS of state Government.

- 2. The implementation of e-payment is aimed to overcome the shortcoming of existing system such as delay in transmission of fund to actual payee, delay in receiving of physical scrolls and vouchers from banks for timely accounting, parking of funds in bank or with DDOs and difficulty caused thereby in monitoring the cash balances including that of with RBI for daily W&M management.
- 3. E-kuber is core banking solution of RBI and RBI will act as agency bank for entire treasury. Integration will be done in the phased manner. Capital Treasury Shimla is to be linked immediately on pilot basis and subsequently all other treasuries will be linked to e-kuber over a period of time.
- 4. Main feature of e-kuber includes;-(a) Provision of single treasury wise account. (b) Decentralized access to this account. (c) Government user can monitor their balances in a consolidated manner through e-kuber so as to help them in fund management. (d) UTR no in respect of each transaction.
- In this system government payment/ disbursement will be made electronically directly in the bank account of payee i.e. employee, vendor, pensioner etc. After passing of bill by treasury an e-advice (pay order) digitally signed by HIMKOSH will be generated and placed on RBI SFTP. The RBI will make the payment through NEFT/RTGS/ECS, as the case may be, as per the e-advice received from the concerned treasury.
- 6. The detailed procedure to be followed by DDO's and treasuries is at Annexure "A" and changes to be incorporated by NIC is at Annexure "B".

7. Petty payments/Statutory dues: - However, option for payment through cash/cheque/draft petty expenditure not exceeding Rs 5000/- and statutory dues like tax and user charges will be available to DDO. Such payments will be drawn and parked into

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Treasuries account opened for this specific purpose. After receiving the payment confirmation treasuries will issue NEFT advice with specific instruction for mode of payment like (cash/draft/banker cheque).

- In challan mode of payment the funds will be parked into treasury account in the first instance. After receiving account credit continuation, Treasury will issue a NEFT advice along with the challan received with the bills to the attached agency bank for receipt
- The relevant rules & orders in HPTR 2017 are deemed to be amended to this extend for implementation of e-payment through e-kuber.

# Role of DDO

- I. DDO will register new vendor in register payee module. All the details will be prevalidated before adding the payee on HPTR 5 through RBI e-kuber account validation utility
- 2. After the successful validation, the payee will be added and bill can be completed and send to treasury.
- 3 From validation of bill to passing of bill for some reason if account is closed or changed, the RBL system will reject the payment; If the bill has multiple payee the whole bill be returned to the DDO.
- 4 The DDO will either remove the payee from bill or correct the payee details and resubmit the bill to the treasury.

## Role of Treasury

- Le Treasuries will follow all the existing procedure till pay order generation.
- 2. As there is real time settlement, treasury will generate pay order every hour to keep the number of payee small in pay order, with
- 3 Treasuries will push the file on RBF SFTP for the payment and wait for the acknowledgment.
- 4. As RBI runs payment batch every 30 minutes, after 30 minutes status of whole file will be available to the Treasury.
- 5. In case of wrong details, treasury will unlock the pay order and remove the particular bills from the pay order and them lock and upload pay order again on the RBL.
- 6 Treasury wise account statement will be available on the next working day. The daily seroll will be downloaded and compliation of bills will be done on the basis of escroll.
- 7. In case of e-salary bills files will be pushed to SFTP on every 25th of the month.

# Changes required in application (e-bills/e-salary/HPOLTIS)

- As per e-kuber V 2.7, government will go with complete file rejection or acceptance model.
- 2. Account validation facility of RBI will be integrated.
- 3. All the previous accounts may be validated in one go and new accounts will be validated at the time of addition by DDO.
- 4. The payee can only be available to DDOonce it is pre-validated from RB

## HPOLTIS

- Facility to upload files on SFTP of RBI and download acknowledgment and consuming rejection files be made available.
- 2. On the basis of rejected records, treasury will remove the particular bill from the pay order and object the same and return to the DDO.
- 3. After removing the erroneous record the treasuries will upload the file again.
- 4. Treasuries can download the e-scroll and compile the account on the basis of e-scroll.

## E-salary/Ebills

- 1. As government will integrate full rejection model, the e-salary files may be placed on 25th of the month. So the rejected record can be rectified on time.

  After the rectification of account details by the DDO the treasuries may upload the files again.
- 2. To facilitate the above sthere is need of unlocking the warrant no at freasury level so account details can be changed.
- 3. Treasury bank account to be freezed for challan mode of payment in eBills,

### Monitoring at DTA

Interface to view the freasury wise daily account statement of RBI and status of salary files may be also be made available to DTA.

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
