Minutes of 2nd meeting of State Level Committee for New India@75 Campaign held under the Chairpersonship of Dr. Archana Soni, Project Director, HPSACS, Shimla on dated 7th August 2021 at 1:30 PM

The 2nd meeting of State Level Committee for New India@75 Campaign to review preparation of 1st Phase of Campaign from 12th of 20th August 2021 in the Districts of Hamirpur; Kangra & Mandi and update on the Campaign at National State level was organized on 7th August 2021 at 1:30 PM.

Following discussion held and decision taken in the meeting:-

- (1) Total 7 districts have been selected for New India@75 Campaign in Himachal Pradesh and for first phase of Campaign from 12th to 20th August 2021, three District i.e. Hamirpur, Kangra & Una have selected. The list of Schools and Colleges participating in the 1st Phase of Campaign starting from 12th August 2021 and plan have been shared with all the members of Committee. The plan is at Annexure 1'.
- (2) It has informed to all concerned that budget has been released and norms for the activities are at Annexure-'2'.

In this regard, it was decided that for Schools budget will be released to Deputy Director (Higher Education) of concerned District for further release the same to Schools. The Department of Higher Education, HP will also issue instruction to Deputy Director (Higher Education) of concerned District.

- (4) Reporting format for District Level and College/School level at Annexure-'3', '4' & '5'.
- (5) Good photographs, videos and reports of activities to be shared by Schools & Colleges to CMO/DAPO and by CMO/DAPO to HPSACS.
- (6) 1st prize winner entry from each school & college and each theme event to be shared by school/college to CMOs/DAPOs and by CMOs/DAPOs to HPSACS by 25th of August 2021 for further sending the same to NACO by HPSACS.

- (7) For One minute video competition 1st winner, 2nd winner and 3rd winner videos to be shared by Schools and Colleges to CMOs/DAPOs immediately after declaring winners and by CMOs/DAPOs to HPSACS immediately to HPSACS for sharing on social media handles of HPSACS.
- (8) Photographs of Campaign also shared by DAPOs with HPSACS for updating the same on Social Media of HPSACS.
- (9) All members were informed that Secretary Health & Family Welfare, Government of India will Launch Campaign and 50 students from each school and 50 students from each RRC College. The list of students attending Launch from each College and School alongwith Nodal officer and Brand Ambassador Student from each School & College will be provided by District AIDS Programme Officer to HPSACS by 9th August 2021. The Department of Higher Education, HP will issue Instruction to all Schools and Colleges for the same.
- (10) It was intimated by Mrs. Surindra Sharma Deputy Director, Department of Higher Education, HP that 10th to 12th classes are being operational, therefore, students will attend Launch function from schools and whereas 9th class students will attend online. Also, it was informed by Deputy Director, Department of Higher Education, HP that in schools 9th and 11th classes may not have 50 students each. In this regard, PD HPSACS suggested to involve 10th and +2 students in such cases.
- (11) All the Districts were requested to conduct District Level Committee meetings under the Chairmanship of Deputy Commissioner for better coordination and successful organization of Campaign.
- The activities on HIV theme cover topics such as HIV testing, Elimination of Mother To Child Transmission of Infection (EMTCT), AIDS Helpline 1097, NACO AIDS APP and Stigma & Discrimination. For TB topics suggested by IEC Officer, NTEP, HP such as Nikashay Poshan Yojana, Financial Support Scheme to MDR Patients, Elimination of TB before deadline of GoI i.e. 2025, Ensure treatment adherence, Sunday ACF & TB & Co-morbidities. For Blood Donations topics suggested by AD(VBD), HPSACS such as Types of blood donors advantages and disadvantages, Selection criteria for Voluntary blood donation (who can donate blood), Deferral criteria for blood donation (who cannot donate blood), Post donation precautions, Need of blood donation & Whole blood and blood components.
- (13) Also, it was discussed with IEC Officer of NTEP, HP that HPSACS has approved budget of Rs. 1800/per college (total 25 colleges) and Rs. 1000/- per school (total 25 schools) for each theme i.e. HIV,
 TB & Blood Donation and if it is possible for NTEP, HP support for prizes of TB topic for which in
 each phase total Rs. 90000/- expenditure will be incurred. On this, IEC Officer, NTEP, HP has
 informed that they have already allocated budget under FMR 11.17.1 to Districts and they may
 meet out expenditure for TB prize from the same and instructions for the same will also be issued by
 NTEP, HP to concerned Districts. District-wise budget for prizes related to TB competition for
 1st Phase is at Annexure-'6'.
- (14) District AIDS Programme Officers to ensure District & Field Level publicity of Campaign on following lines:-
 - (i) Pre Publicity Press releases from Districts and Schools/Colleges, Social Media, free of cost programmes in AIR such Hello Doctor, Bites/News on Local Cable Channels etc.
 - (ii) Publicity throughout Campaign Press releases from Districts and Schools/Colleges, Social Media, free of cost programmes in AIR such Hello Doctor, Bites/News on Local Cable Channels etc.

These media reports are to be shared with HPSACS alongwith report of Campaign.

- (15) The Department of Information & Public Relations, HP was requested for publicity of Campaign through press releases, articles, new in Himachal Bulletin etc. and similar instructions issued to concerned District Public Relations Officers. Ms. Mamta Negi ensured that full support will be provided by their Department for publicity of Campaign.
- (16) NSS was requested to ensure that their support through active participation of their volunteer students in the Campaign activities in Schools & Colleges. Sh. Dalip Thakur, Programme Coordinator NSS (Schools) ensured for their full support and also instructions will be issued in this regard.
- (17) The support of other Departments and Organizations discussed in the meeting and is at Annexure '7'; all the member Departments and Organizations were requested for their support. PD HPSACS directed HPSACS officer (s)/official (s) that as some member Departments and Organizations not in the meeting, therefore, one separate meeting with these be organized.
- (18) It was also informed to all Districts that District Level Quiz will be organized in all 7 Districts selected for New India@75 Campaign, the Districts in 1st Phase i.e. Hamirpur, Kangra & Mandi to complete District Level Quiz competition by 20th of August 2021 and District Bilaspur, Shimla, Solan & Una to complete District level competition by 31st August 2021. All RRCs to participate in the Quiz and participation of Schools & Colleges participating in New India@75 Campaign is mandatory. The quidelines for District Level Quiz will be same as in last financial year 2020-21.
- (19) During the meeting discussions, it was came to notice that for better coordination is required at District level within Health Department, Education Department and RRC-Colleges and Schools. In this regard, it was decided that meeting of all 25 schools and 25 colleges, Deputy Directors (HE), District AIDS Programme Officers, officers from Higher Education Department and officers from HPSACS will be organized by Department of Higher Education and date & time will be informed to all concerned. The online link of meeting will be created by HPSACS.
- (20) The Project Director HPSACS requested to DAPOs for ensuring effective monitoring of Campaign and each school-wise & college-wise monitoring officer (s)/official (s) to be assigned by CMO/DAPO and they will regularly monitor organization of activities. As per the directions of PD HPSACS, details of Officers/Officials for monitoring to be intimated by 10th August 2021 as per **Annexure'8'** and format of monitoring has been developed by HPSACS and attached at **Annexure-'9'** which will be provided by CMO/DAPO to HPSACS.
