मैं, आपका ध्यान दिनांक 5 जुलाई, 2019 के समसंख्यक अ.शा.पत्र की ओर दिलाना चाहूँगा जो साइबर अपराध को प्रभावी रूप से नियंत्रित करने के लिए परितंत्र तैयार करने के संबंध में है।

मुझे यह बताते हुए अतिप्रसन्नता हो रही है कि गृह मंत्रालय ने देश भर में समन्वित और व्यापक रूप से साइबर अपराध से निपटने के लिए 'भारतीय साइबर अपराध समन्वय केंद्र (आई4सी)' योजना तैयार की है। इस योजना के तहत गृह मंत्रालय ने साइबर अपराध की घटनाओं की रिपोर्ट करने के लिए 'समुन्नत पोर्टल' (www.cybercrime.gov.in) आरंभ किया है। इस पोर्टल पर, विशेष रूप से महिलाओं एवं बच्चों के विरुद्ध होने वाले साइबर अपराधों सहित, सभी साइबर अपराधों की रिपोर्ट की जा सकती है। इस पोर्टल की विशेषताएं अनुलग्नक-1 पर उपलब्ध हैं।

इस पोर्टल के शुरू होने से अब तक जनता द्वारा साइबर अपराध की 23,000 से अधिक घटनाओं की रिपोर्ट की जा चुकी है। हालांकि, यह देखा गया है कि केवल 167 घटनाएं ही एफआईआर में तब्दील हुई हैं। मैं रिपोर्ट किए गए तथा एफ.आई.आर. दर्ज किए गए साइबर अपराध मामलों का राज्यवार ब्यौरा संलग्न कर रहा हूँ। (अनुलग्नक-1) इस पोर्टल पर रिपोर्ट की गई शिकायतों के निपटान की गति से संबंधित आंकड़े भी संलग्न हैं। मैं इस बात पर जोर देना चाहूँगा कि बाल अश्लील साहित्य और बलात्कार-सामूहिक-बलात्कार के चित्रांकन से संबंधित शिकायतों को देखने के बारे में माननीय उच्चतम न्यायालय के निर्धारित मानदंडों के अनुसार 36 घंटों के भीतर शिकायत की जाँच की जाए जिसमें, यदि आवश्यक हो, तो विषयवस्तु को हटाने का नोटिस भी शामिल है। जनता पोर्टल पर रिपोर्ट किए गए सभी प्रकार के साइबर अपराधों के निपटान के लिए इसी प्रकार के मानदंड की उम्मीद करती है। हालांकि, यह देखा जा सकता है कि 72 घंटे बीत जाने के बाद भी 4400 से अधिक शिकायतें कार्रवाई के लिए लंबित हैं।

यह समुचित होगा कि संबंधित अधिकारियों द्वारा इन सभी साइबर अपराध मामलों की जाँच की जाए और प्राथमिकता के आधार पर उपयुक्त कार्रवाई की जाए। महिलाओं और बच्चों से संबंधित साइबर अपराध मामलों पर विशेष ध्यान दिया जाए। हमारा पोर्टल साइबर अपराधों की संयुक्त/सहयोगपूर्ण जाँच के एक सुचारू ढाँचे का विकास भी कर रहा है क्योंकि असंदिग्ध पीड़ितों के प्रति सीमा से बाहर वाले साइबर अपराध की प्रकृति और मामले अनेक पीड़ितों को लक्ष्य बनाने वाले एक जैसे अपराधियों की ओर अग्रसर करते हैं। आप इस संबंध में अपने पुलिस विभाग को अपनी संबंधित पुलिस एजेंसियों के साथ सहयोग करने का निर्देश दे सकते हैं।

इसी प्रकार, आम जनता, पुलिस अधिकारियों, अध्यापकों और लोक अभियोजकों को सूचना प्रौद्योगिकी अधिनियम, 2000 के मूलभूत प्रावधानों तथा लिखित सामग्री, फोटोग्राफों, संगीत और वीडियो इत्यादि पर कॉपीराइट कानून के बारे में जागरूक बनाए जाने की आवश्यकता है। एंटीवायरस, फायरवॉल, साइबर सुरक्षा के सर्वोत्तम उपाय, क्लाउड कम्प्यूटिंग, विकोडन, आर्टिफिशल इंटेलिजेंस, मशीन लर्निंग इत्यादि जैसे संबंधित विषयों से भी लोगों को परिचित करवाए जाने की आवश्यकता है। इस संबंध में, लोगों में जागरूकता फैलाने के लिए आप उद्योग जगत, शिक्षाविदों और गैर-सरकारी संगठनों का सहयोग प्राप्त कर सकते हैं।

साइबर अपराध की सीमाहीन और जटिल प्रवृत्ति को देखते हुए, यह जरूरी है कि देश के विभिन्न एल.ई.ए. एक साझा प्लेटफॉर्म पर आए। साइबर अपराध के मुद्दे से प्रभावी रूप से निपटने के लिए यह अत्यावश्यक है कि आई 4 सी प्लेटफॉर्म के साथ जुड़कर कार्य करने के लिए राज्य/संघ राज्य स्तर पर राज्य/क्षेत्रीय साइबर अपराध समन्वय केंद्र (आर4सी) की स्थापना की जाए। आई4सी और अन्य एजेंसियों के बीच साइबर अपराध के बारे में साइबर अपराध आसूचना/धमकियों की सूचना के निर्बाध आदान-प्रदान से साइबर अपराधों को कम करने के हमारे प्रयासों में सहायता मिलेगी। इस संबंध में, राज्य/संघ राज्य स्तर पर क्षेत्रीय साइबर अपराध समन्वय केंद्र (आर4सी) की स्थापना करने के लिए मेरे मंत्रालय द्वारा दिनांक 23.09.2019 को जारी एडवाइजरी की प्रति भी सुलभ संदर्भ के लिए संलग्न है। मैं इस सहयोग-पटल को जल्द से जल्द शुरू करने में आपके सहयोग के लिए अनुरोध करता हूँ।

मुझे विश्वास है कि हमारे सहयोगपूर्ण प्रयासों से साइबर अपराधों को प्रभावी रूप से नियंत्रित करने के लिए एक पारितंत्र बनाने में मदद मिलेगी। मैं आपके सहयोग की आशा करता हूँ और आपको यह विश्वास दिलाता हूँ कि साइबर अपराध के विरुद्ध संयुक्त लड़ाई के प्रयासों में मेरे मंत्रालय का सहयोग आपको लगातार मिलता रहेगा।

Subject: Setting up of Cyber Crime Coordination Centre in States/UTs – collaboration with Indian Cyber Crime Coordination Centre

In order to deal with cyber crimes in a coordinated and comprehensive manner across the country, MHA has rolled out a scheme 'Indian Cyber Crime Coordination Centre (I4C)'. The vision of I4C is to establish an effective framework and ecosystem for prevention, detection, investigation and prosecution of cyber crime cases". The I4C aims to realize this vision by working on following objectives:

- i. To act as a nodal point to curb cybercrimes.
- ii. To act as an early warning system for law enforcement agencies for detection and prevention of cyber crimes.
- iii. Suggest amendments, if required, in cyber laws to keep pace with fast changing technologies and International cooperation.
- iv. To coordinate activities related to implementation of Mutual Legal Assistance Treaties (MLAT) with other countries regarding cyber-crimes in consultation with the concerned nodal authority in MHA.
- v. Capacity building and public awareness.
- vi. Ecosystem for cyber forensic for professional investigation
- vii. Ecosystem for curbing cyber crimes in synergistic manner

2. Under I4C, this ministry is undertaking following activities:

1. **National Cybercrime Threat Analytics Unit (TAU)**. National Cybercrime TAU is a platform for law enforcement personnel, private sector, academia and research organizations to work collaboratively to analyze all pieces of information relating to cybercrimes; produce cybercrime threat reports and cybercrime trend analysis. This unit is now operational and already sharing cyber crime threat intelligence reports derived on the basis of open source monitoring. An online platform is being developed for sharing of such inputs with respective States/UTs.

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II. **National Cyber Crime Reporting Portal:** The new portal www.cybercrime.gov.in has been made operational on 30-8-2019, which enables reporting of all cybercrimes with particular focus on cybercrimes against women and children. In this regard, several advisories issued by this Ministry may please be referred. Till date, over 2000 complaints have been reported and most of the States/UTs have started handling the reported complaints. A toll free helpline number 155260 has also been made operational in all States/UTs.

III. **Platform for Joint Cybercrime Investigation Team:** It aims to establish a platform for (i) Joint Cybercrime Investigation (ii) Coordinated action against key threats and targets (iii) Joint identification, prioritization, preparation to combat cyber threats and (iv) Initiation of multi-jurisdictional investigations and operations. National Cyber Crime Reporting Portal tags all the complaints reported on the portal which have same suspect credentials, to facilitate concerned States/UTs for such collaboration.

IV. **National Cybercrime Forensic Laboratory Ecosystem:** It aims to establish (i) National Evidence Repository (ii) Cloud Based Access to NCFL from States / UTs (iii) Bolster NCFL to develop as a centre to support investigation process and (iv) NCFL and associated CFSLs to be well-equipped and well-staffed. NCFL has been made operational on 18-2-2019 in New Delhi and is being upgraded to offer more tools and facilities to investigating officers (IOs). SOP has been developed for making available these facilities to IOs and a portal is being developed for this purpose.

V. **National Cybercrime Training Centre:** It would focus on standardization of course curriculum, development of hands-on training modules for cybercrime detection, containment and reporting using simulated cyber environments. Development of MOOCs (Massive Open Online Courses) and establish Cyber Range. National Crime Record Bureau will launch MOOC platform.

VI. **Cybercrime Ecosystem Management Unit:** It aims to develop a National Cybercrime Ecosystem including engagement of key stakeholders working in the areas of: (i) Cyber Awareness Promoters (CAP) (ii) Inappropriate Content Flaggers (ICF) (iii) Private Sector Threat Information (PTI) providers (iv) Cyber Civil Defence (CCD) volunteers (v) Indigenous Service Providers (ISPs). Consultations with government, industry and academia have been initiated. A concept note on cyberdost volunteers has been drafted and CDAC Hyderabad has been entrusted with the task of conducting cyber crime awareness week in 10 States/UTs.

VII. **National Cyber Research and Innovation Centre:** It would examine the problem statements of LEAs to develop appropriate solution in collaboration with stakeholders in academia, private sector or inter-governmental organizations. BPR&D is setting up this facility; and problem statements of law

enforcement agencies are being compiled which will be taken up for development of technology solutions with the help of industry and academia.

3. While States/UTs have independent legal authority, however, given the borderless and complex nature of cybercrime, it is important for various LEAs in the country to converge on a common platform. I4C has been setup with the objective of enabling LEAs to counter emerging cyber crime threats in collaborative and effective manner. In order to tackle the issue of cybercrimes robustly, it is imperative that Regional cyber crime coordination center (R4C) at the State/UT level is established, in convergence with I4C platform. The exchange of cyber crime intelligence/threat feed w.r.t cybercrimes between I4C and other agencies will lead to synergy in our efforts to curb cyber crimes.
4. Each R4C can share information with I4C to contribute in the enhancement of cybercrime threat intelligence ecosystem. The same agencies can also leverage I4C infrastructure and intelligence ecosystem to improve its current preparedness or take inputs for any on-going investigations. Few illustrative domains where I4C and other agencies can work together are as follows:
 - i. Work collaboratively to analyze cyber crime patterns.
 - ii. Formulate cyber crime threat intelligence reports/threat feeds and organize periodic interactions.
 - iii. Respond in real-time to rapidly changing cybercrime threat.
 - iv. Intelligence-led coordinated action against key cybercrime threats and targets.
 - v. Exchange best practices on emerging technologies & digital forensics.
 - vi. Proactively predict potential vulnerabilities, which can be exploited by cybercriminals.
 - vii. Capacity building.

5. Implementation approach for R4Cs

The States/UTs have already designated nodal officers at State/UT level for handling of cyber crime complaints reported on National Cyber Crime Reporting portal. Same units or any other unit may be designated by the States/UTs as their Regional Cyber Crime Coordination Centre (R4C). These units may use logo of I4C in their communications and may be equipped with trained staff, equipment etc. To start with, following is proposed as roles & functions of R4Cs:


- i. Leverage National Cyber Crime Reporting portal for prompt disposal of reported complaints and provide feedback to I4C for improvements as per needs.
- ii. Promote inter-state collaboration for handling of multi jurisdictional cyber crime cases.
- iii. Take up cyber crime awareness initiatives for people to help them get protected from cyber crimes.

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- iv. Share modus operandi of cyber criminals and best practices for handling cyber crime cases with I4C for all India dissemination.
- v. Coordinate for leveraging the facility of National Cyber Crime Training Centre for capacity building of their officers, including certificate based e-learning modules as part of induction & in-service training of law enforcement officers, public prosecutors and judicial officers.
- vi. Help National Cyber Crime Training Centre in development of simulation based courseware and its conversion in vernacular content for MOOC platform.
- vii. Share cyber crime threat intelligence and advisories with I4C in the template prescribed by I4C.
- viii. Promote usage of NCFL eco system facility, by investigating officers in their territory.
- ix. Removal/blocking of unlawful content.
- x. Capacity building.

6. It is requested to designate State/UT cyber nodal cell or any other appropriate unit to function as Cyber Crime Coordination Centre for the State/UT as a partner of the Indian Cyber Crime Coordination Centre to discharge the role and function as detailed above. Suggestions for improving the I4C-R4C collaboration framework are welcome. An early action on setting up of regional cyber crime coordination centre in your State/UT may please be taken and its relevant details shared with this Ministry so that collaboration with I4C gets materialized.
