However, a policy is only as good as its implementation by the State Government organs. Hence, the concerned departments must ensure that all gaps for effective implementation must be plugged".

Now therefore, in compliance with the directions passed by the National Human Rights Commission (NHRC) you are directed to adhere the guidelines/steps mentioned in the HP Integrated Drug Prevention Policy in true letter & spirit in the educational institutions.

I am directed to enclose herewith a copy of letter No.HFW-A-A01/9/2024 HEALTH-A dated 19.07.2024 received from the Special Secretary (Health) to the Govt. of HP along with its enclosures on the subject cited above.

The National Human Rights Commission (Law Division), New Delhi vide its letter dated 07.06.2024 (copy enclosed) has informed that the Commission took suo moto cognizance of news item published in the "Times of India" dated 13.04.2023 under caption "Doon rehab inmates were kept hundry for days" and issued notices to the Chief Secretaries of all the States/UTs to give a detailed report on the De-addiction Centres being run by them.

On reply submitted by the department of Social Justice & Empowerment Govt. of HP, dated 09.01.2023, the Commission, with respect to the "HP Integrated Drug Prevention Policy" has directed as "it appears that the policy framework for Himachal Pradesh is in place. However, a policy is only as good as its implementation by the State Government organs. Hence, the concerned departments must ensure that all gaps in effective implementation must be plugged".
