Regarding admission process and distribution of sections in the Colleges. Clarifications thereof.

Sir,

I am directed to refer to this department notification No.EDN-A-Kha(1)2/2013 dated 14th March 2014 on the subject cited above and to say that it has come to the notice of the Government that same colleges are not being making the admission process as per the instructions issued by the Government. It is therefore, clarified:-

- 1. It seems that some colleges are fixing a upper limit of Two Sections in a particular Major subject even though there is sufficient staff and closing the enrolment after 120 students means only two sections of 60 students only. It is clarified that there is no section limit and the college administration is directed to fix number of sections keeping in view the availability of teachers.
- 2. The class size of Major Subjects in theory has been indicated to be 60 students. However, the 1st Section is to be counted upto 80 students. This has wrongly been interpreted to 60. In the first section, the students uupto 80 are to be admitted and second section be started if the students enrolment is more than 80. The third section will start after the enrolment of 140 students and fourth after 200 and thereon.
- For Minor subject, it has already been decided that the students strength in the range of 80-100 for 1st Section and thereon.
- 4. Other instructions will remain the same as notified in the notification mentioned to above.

You are, therefore, requested to clarify the same to all the concern with the directions for strict compliance at the earliest.
