- > Teachers should be upto 52 years of age (Birth Certificate to be produced at the time of registration).
- ➤ Teachers teaching in minimum any one of the Classes $-6^{th}/7^{th}/8^{th}/9^{th}/10^{th}/11^{th}/12^{th}$ of middle/secondary/senior secondary schools should only be deputed.
- > S/he should be teaching subjects like i) Social Study (History, Geography, Economics, Civics, Sociology etc.); ii) Languages (Hindi, English, Sanskrit, Modern Indian Languages); iii) Science (Physics, Chemistry, Biology, etc.); iv) Mathematics; v) Commerce, vi) Fine Arts, Music & Art;
- Preference should be given to depute female teachers.
- The deputed teachers should have minimum two years' experience of teaching.
- > Only one teacher from one school should be deputed in each of the above mentioned Orientation Course(s), not more than one teacher from the same school will be allowed to participate.

Parameters for the Teachers Deputation in CCRT - Orientation Course

The Centre of Cultural Resources and Training (CCRT) is a premier institute that aspires and working towards connecting Indian culture with education through its vivid Training Programmes.

The Orientation (Basic Foundation) Course is a specialized skill building training conceptualized and conducted by CCRT for for middle/secondary/ senior secondary school in-service teachers and teacher educators from all parts of the country. CCRT consistently makes an effort in providing contemporary trainings that address issues of cultural integration, cultural appreciation, cultural richness and diversity of various Indian regions and empowering teachers to inculcate pride in national Heritage.

We hereby state some guidelines for nomination of teachers for the CCRT training.

This may be ensured by the respective deputing authorities from the State/UTs.

- 1. Only permanent/regular teachers of middle/secondary/senior secondary schools up to the age of 52 years should be nominated for attending the Orientation (Basic Foundation) Course. The teachers must have completed at least two years regular service, then only should be nominated /deputed for the Orientation Course.
- 2. Teacher participants who have already attended Orientation (Basic Foundation) Course (in HQ New Delhi or any regional centers), should not be nominated again. The benefit of the course needs to reach out to many more teachers, so that there is wide spread propagation of cultural aspects in education.
- 3. Primary School teachers teaching only up to V (5th) Standard, are not to be nominated for this Orientation (Basic 2 Foundation) Course as the course content is appropriate for middle and higher class integration. State Directorate of Education/SCERTs, DEO must avoid deputing Primary School Teachers in the Orientation (Basic Foundation) Course rather send their nominations for other CCRT programmes that are designed particularly for primary school level.

with their local culture to share it in a national platform. Therefore the teacher participants are encouraged to bring books, research papers, PPTs etc related to their respective local/regional culture.

- 13. During the Orientation Course the participant teachers are supposed to present their states 'Regional contribution to Indian Culture'. In this regard they can bring their regional traditional dresses/ethnic wares, portable cultural items that may be useful in their aforesaid presentation or performance.
- 14. The deputed teachers are representatives of their state. Therefore He/she must conduct oneself as responsible & respectful to people from all regions, religion and caste. The participants should be guided and are expected to dress in formal with modestly and aptly on all training days.
- 15. Usually the training programmes are scheduled between 09:00 AM till 5: 30 PM. However depending upon the necessity timings maybe changed or extended. After 5.30 pm they will be assigned self learning, reading and group discussion exercises that they need to participate as necessary part of assimilation and application of training. Teacher participants should be instructed that they are required to follow the schedule, participate in all activities and to be prompt and punctual.
- 16. In general taking leaves during the training programe is not entertained. However, only on medical and unpreventable cases it may be allowed by the prior permission from the Deputy Director (Training)/ Course Director CCRT.
- 17. Consumption of Alcohol and any other addictive's are strictly prohibited during the programme tenure and strict action would be taken in this regard if the rules and code of conduct is not adhered to by CCRT officials. Your kind cooperation is solicited in the matter.
- 18. In case the deputed teachers do not fulfill the terms and conditions of the mentioned guidelines they will neither be registered nor paid TA by CCRT for reporting.
