Directives of Hon'ble PM	The problem of drug abuse may be dealt as a social problem and a wider consultative and multipronged strategy including experts from Police, Agriculture, Veterinary, MEA, experts of National Security, chemicals and pharmaceuticals, psychologists and medical experts to be developed to address the problem.
Terms of References	 Supply reduction:- Coordination among the Drug Law Enforcement Agencies for enhancing enforcement activities. Addressing the issue of involvement of foreigners in Drug trafficking. Involvement of terrorists/insurgents/ LWE in Drug Trafficking activities. Issue of illicit crop cultivation and the roles of various agencies including Agriculture/Veterinary Deptt. etc-Role of Alternative Development. Issue of dual use of chemical/ pharmaceutical Drugs and exploring the feasibility of their alternatives.
