I am directed to forward herewith a DO letter dated 22nd May 2023 received from Election Commission of India informing that with the Lok Sabha Elections 2024 approaching, voter education for electoral participation has now acquired a new sense of urgency. Young voters hold the key to the country's future and their low participation has been a cause of concern. In this regard the ECI has suggested to State Education Department to designate. Hectoral Literacy Clubs (H.Cs) to disseminate information amongst school/College-going students in an engaging manner focusing on participatory activities, games, films, etc./ It has been further informed that the FLCs in schools/colleges for new/future voters, and other co-curriculum activities for imparting voter awareness amongst students will make them Exulty conversant with the electoral system of the country and inculcate in them the willingness to register as voters and participate in every election in a passionate, informed, ad ethical manner. The EC+ has also suggested long-term measures, which require continuous and sustained attention on the following areas a. Integrate voter education and electoral literacy in a systematic manner in the curricular framework under NCF for all schools and colleges in an age appropriate manner and b. Integrate voter education and electoral literacy appropriately in the curricular framework for all colleges/universities in a manner and to the extent of credit & hours suitable for Introduce/update textbooks of NCERT to incorporate electoral literacy and advise State Education Boards and other Boards to do the same; Orients/ train teachers in imparting electoral literacy in the classrooms; Mainstream voter education content in teaching, learning and assessment, and voter education and electoral literacy in pre-service teacher education courses, and Devise a system of credits for students taking part in CEDE to pursue higher studies. In this regard, it is requested to take necessary action on above points and activities and share your comments/ ATR on the above directly to the TCL this issues with the approval of Competent Authority Yours taithfully, taxu by Deputy Secretary to the Covernment of India Line L.
