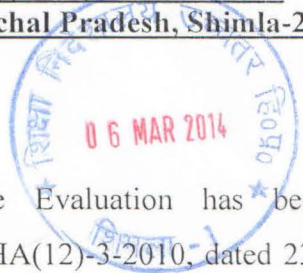

## Notification



Whereas Continuous and Comprehensive Evaluation has been introduced in the State notified vide notification no. Shiksha-II-KHA(12)-3-2010, dated 23<sup>rd</sup> July, 2010 as per Section-29 of Right of Children to Free and Compulsory Education Act, 2009(RTE Act, 2009). It has come to the notice of the Government that students are not acquiring desired learning levels. No evaluation against set standards has been identified as one of the main reasons for the same.

Now therefore, in view of the above and also the goals enshrined in the National Education Policy-1986 (revised in 1992) the Govt. of H.P. is pleased to notify the 'Learning Standards' class-wise and subject-wise. Every teacher in the classroom shall henceforth evaluate the abilities of each child as per these standards; they shall also provide remedial teaching to students so that desired level of learning is achieved by each child.


