Dear Sir,

The NDMA, as the apex body for disaster management in India, has the mandate for laying down policies, plans and guidelines for Disaster Management (DM) in the country and to coordinate their enforcement and implementation for ensuring timely and effective response to disasters.

2. The 'National School Safety Programme (NSSP)' implemented by the Authority in partnership with the States/UT Governments has been implemented in 8600 schools in 43 districts spread over 22 States/UTs of the country falling in seismic zone IV & V.

3. One of the important learnings' of the project was that these awareness campaigns and preparedness drills in schools have made important contribution towards enhanced risk awareness amongst children who in turn have become ambassadors of safety thereby spreading awareness in their communities.

4. Therefore, States are advised to conduct mock/disaster preparedness drills in schools at a convenient time and date in the month of April-May 2016. It is critical that conduction of these drills in schools is meticulously planned and adequate safety measures are taken in advance leading to conduction of safe and error free drill.
