Sir,

Ministry of Home Affairs, GoI, has decided to conduct Forensic Aptitude and Calibre Test (FACT) to standardize and benchmark the standards to engage a large number of qualified students for assisting forensic science experts in the Central and State FSLs to expedite the disposal of pending cases on short term or need based forensic assignments.

2. MHA has further decided that the LNJN National Institute of Criminology & Forensic Science (NICFS) will organize the examination processes of the FACT on yearly basis, being a nodal institute of Forensic Science education & training in the country. FACT 2018 is a computer based online all India examination and is being organized for the first time by NICFS at 15 specified examination centres in the country. The test has been scheduled for 23rd September, 2018 (Sunday) for 2 hours duration from 10:30 to 12:30 hrs. involving tests of aptitude and caliber in specified disciplines of forensic science.


3. The online tests across the country will be conducted by a GoI agency namely National Institute of Electronics and Information Technology 'NIELIT' at the scheduled time as mentioned above at all the centres under the supervision of LNJN NICFS, Delhi.

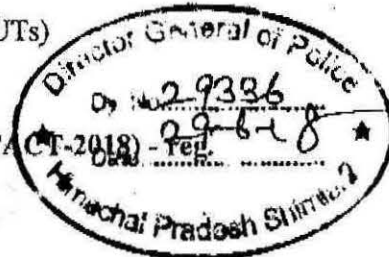
