Proceedings of the meeting of Aman Satya Kachroo Memorial Trust held at Shimla under the Chairmanship of the Chief Secretary to the Govt. of Himachal Pradesh on 06.08.13. The following trustees attended the meeting:

1. Principal Secretary (Health) to the Govt. of H.P.

2. Principal Secretary (Education) to the Govt. of H.P.

3. Vice Chancellor, H.P University.

4. Director NRHM &Special Secretary (Health) to the Govt. of H.P.

5. Principal, DRPGMC, Kangra at Tanda.

At the outset of the meeting the Principal welcomed the members on behalf of the Chairman and gave a brief introduction about the trust, its objectives and agenda items of the meeting. The following decisions were taken during the meeting:

- (i) The Principal Dr. R.P. Govt. Medical College, Kangra at Tanda read out the proceedings of the second meeting held under the Chairmanship of the Principal Secretary Health on 28.2.12 and the same were unanimously approved.
- (ii) Dr. Manju Singh, Joint Secretary, UGC and Mr. Praveen Vashist, Headmaster, the Lawrence School, Sanawar, whose names were suggested by Dr. Rajender Kachroo father of late Amann Satya Kachroo for nomination as trustees for a period of two years as per indenture of the trust, were approved.
- Workshops would be held in various educational institutions by the H.P. University and the Department of Education to spread awareness about zero tolerance to ragging in addition to social and moral evils like substance and alcohol abuse.
- Mentoring cells would be formed in various educational institutions especially health and technical institutions.
- (v) Department of education will consider the possibility of appointing a counsellor in all Govt. institutions of higher education.
- (vi) The Department of health will consider the possibility of appointing counsellors in the district hospitals.
- (vii) It was decided to increase the scholarships to be awarded from the funds of the respective Rogi Kalyan Samiti on merit-cum-means basis from one to two students each of DRPGMC Tanda, Govt. Dental College Shimla and Nursing College Shimla. It was also decided to increase the amount from Rs.1500/- to Rs.3000/- per month.
- (viii) The proposed IEC activities in association with NRHM for the current academic year were approved. The first advocacy workshop for promoting the concept of holistic health amongst students would be held at 4.00pm on 30.08.13 at IGMC, Shimla. A booklet on anti ragging rules and regulations will be printed and distributed to the students.
- (ix) The next meeting of the trust would be held on 8<sup>th</sup> March 2014 at Tanda along with an interactive session with students of adjoining Universities and Institutions.
