Prime Minister's live address to all school children (TV broadcast, Website, Videos Streaming on YouTube, broad on Radio, etc.) on the occasion of Teacher's Day on the 5<sup>th</sup> September, 2014.

Memo:

On the occasion of Teacher's Day 05<sup>th</sup> September, 2014 the Prime Minister of India would be interacting with school children in person in Delhi and through satellite at NIC Centers in Leh, Laddakh, Port Blair in Andaman and Nicobar, Silchar in Assam, Imphal in Manipur, Bhuj in Gujarat, Dantewada in Chhattisgarh and Thini Malai in Tamilnadu.

The Prime Minister AddressQuestion and Answer session with school children will be from 3:00 to 4:45 P.M. The Prime Minister's interaction with students would be telecast live by Doordarshan through its National and Regional Channels. It would also be available through live Webcasting on different platforms of Doordarshan and the Website of Ministry of Human Resource Development. The programme will also be Aired on AIR(FM Channel). Based on the internal discussions it has been decided that the following modes will be followed for ensuring that every child in Govt. Sr. Sec/ High Schools gets to hear/ watch the programme live:-

(i) Through TV which may be available in the School.

- (ii) Through a TV Which is hired locally and payment made from school Grants/ Students Fund.
- (iii) For \*remote areas" where arrangement of TV viewing facility is not possible, F.M. Radio / Transistors through which school children may be able to listen to the Prime Minister's address.

Thereofre, all the Govt. Sr. Sec/ High schools of Himachal Pradesh are directed to make arrangement to assemble the children from 2:30 P.M. to 4:45 P.M. on that day in order that the children may view the Prime Minister's address on T.V. Further, all the Deputy Directors of Higher Education are directed to remain in the office on Sunday (31st August) from 10.00 A.M. to 2.00 P.M. with some staff members of their respective office.

A report on the arrangement made by your school and the number of students covered by different mode must be sent to this Directorate through concerned Deputy Directors and through e-mail by 11.00 A.M. on 1<sup>st</sup> September,2014.

The Director of Higher Education & other staff members will also remain in the office on Sunday to monitor the arrangements and to receive the feed back from the office of the DDHE of all the Districts.
