

PROCEEDINGS OF THE MEETING OF THE HIMACHAL PRADESH PROMOTTEE SCHOOL LECTURER ASSOCIATION HELD ON 17.11.2014 AT 10.00 A.M UNDER THE CHAIRMANSHIP OF SH. SHASHI BHUSHAN SEKHRI, DIRECTOR OF HIGHER EDUCATION, HP

The officers/officials as shown at Annexure-1 were present in the meeting.

Dr. Raj Krishan Pruthi, Addl. Director of Higher Education (A) welcomed the Chairman- Director of Higher Education, Members of HP Promottee School lecturer Association and other officials in the meeting.

The President of the Association, Sh. Vijay Gautam, expressed gratitude to the Chairperson on behalf of Association for giving time for the meeting. He emphasized that their demands were mainly related to problems faced by them and hoped that it would be solved by the Department.

At the outset, the Chairman welcomed the members of the Association to the meeting. In the welcome address, the Chairman emphasized the important role of Teachers in the Department. and asked to maintain the punctuality and discipline at every stage.

The Demand Charter of the Association was discussed and the decisions arrived at are as follows:-

Demand No. 1. Filling up of more than 125 vacant posts of Headmaster and more than 200 Posts of Principal in Govt. High and Senior Secondary Schools of H.P.

It was informed to the Association that approximately 180 HM & 300 Principal will be promoted very shortly. The Chairman directed the Superintendent 10+2 Branch to put up the matter so that the Higher Authorities could be apprised accordingly.

Action: 10+2 Branch

Demand No. 2. Settlement of 4-9-14 ACP cases at earliest.

The chairman informed the Association that at present, there is no pendency of 4-9-14 cases in Directorate level. The chairman assured that the cases of 4-9-14 received after the due date 9 September 2014 will be take up with Govt. as per the demand of the Association. At present, Tresury officers are putting objections to the 4-9-14 cases. The chairman asked the supdt. +2 branch to do the needful.

Action: 10+ 2 Branch

Demand No. 3. Restoration of A.C.P. on old pattern.

The Chairman assured the Association that the matter would be taken up with the Govt.

Action: 10+2 Branch

Demand No. 4. Filling up of 50% Posts of I.T Lecturer/PGT by promotion from TGT's.

The Chairman advised the Association to send a proposal in this regard so that the matter could be taken up with the Govt. **Action: 10+2 Branch.**

Demand No. 5. Enhancement of H.R.A. equal to 10% of basic pay.

The Chairman advised the Association to send a proposal in this regard so that the matter is taken up with the Govt.

Action: 10+2/Budget Branch

Demand No. 6. Verification of all documents of direct H.M. appointed by H.P. Public Service Commission.

The Chairman Directed Supdt. +2 Branch that the necessary/instruction to be given to all the Deputy Directors regarding this matter.

Action: 10+2 Branch

Demand No. 7. Creation of 8 posts of different subjects in all newly upgraded secondary schools.

The Chairman informed the Association that the matter will be sent to the Government for consideration.

Action: Planning Branch

Demand No. 8. Supplementary exams may be conducted before or after summer vacations in future.

The Chairman informed that the matter will be taken with Secretary H.P. Board of School Education D/Shala Govt. of H.P. very shortly.

Action: 10+2 / General Branch.

Demand No. 9. Revival of 236 Posts of Headmaster which are kept held in abeyance.

The Chairman informed the Association that this demand had already been rejected by the Govt.

Action: Nil

Demand No. 10. Ammendment of R&P rules for the post of Principal as 80:20 on strength basis for TGT cadre and lecturer cadre.

The Association was asked to submit comprehensive proposal in this regard to the Directorate so that it may be taken up with the Govt. as per the Association demand.

Action: 10+2 Branch

Demand No. 11. Redesignation of PGT as lecturer who are promoted after 2010.

The Association was asked to submit comprehensive proposal in this regard to the Directorate so that it may be taken up with the Govt. as per the Association demand.

Action: 10+2 Branch

Demand No. 12. Practical allowance should be given to the entire lecturer who is involved in practical works with teaching.

The decision in this regard is to be taken at Govt. level

Action: 10+2 Branch

Demand No. 13. S.O.S. centre may be run by board itself or separate centre should be created so that the study of regular students may not suffer.

The Association was asked to submit comprehensive proposal in this regard to the Directorate so that the it may be taken with the Govt. as per association demand.

Action: 10+2/ General Branch

Demand No. 14. One post of sweeper may be created in all Sr. Sec. & high school as per old patter.

It is decided by the Government that the post of Sweeper is declared as dying cadre and engage the sweeper on the basis of outsource to complete the work of the school.

Action: Nil

Demand No 15 Honorarium of NSS programme officer may be enhanced up to rupees 500/each P/M.

The Association was asked to submit comprehensive proposal in this regard to the Directorate so that the it may be taken with the Govt. as per association demand.

Action: NSS Branch

Sh. Bihari Lal Prashar, General Secretary expressed his satisfaction on the discussion in the meeting. He was of the view that Department is ever ready to redress their demands/grievances and today also they were given due attention in this regard. The meeting ended with a vote of thanks to Chair.
