**ALL INDIA SAINIK SCHOOLS ENTRANCE EXAMINATION

Sir,

1. May I invite your kind attention to Board of Governors, Sainik Schools Society, Ministry of Defence letter No 5(14)/2011/D (SSC) dated 21 Aug 2013 vide which Ministry of Defence has notified that the All India Sainik Schools Entrance Examination for the session 2014-15 for admission to class VI and IX will be held on 05 Jan 2014 (copy enclosed for ready reference). The School will offer approx 80 and 10 seats for admission to Class VI and IX respectively.
2. It is requested that the Director of Higher Education, the Deputy Directors of Higher Education and Distt Primary Education Officers of all the districts may be asked to accord wide publicity among the Primary, Middle and High Schools under their jurisdiction about the Entrance Examination for admission to this prestigious institution. The information may also be disseminated through all Govt Departments to ensure that all the eligible candidates, even from the remotest areas including Scheduled Caste and Scheduled Tribe categories get to know about this prestigious institution doing yeomen service for the State of HP and Defence of the country by sending maximum number of cadets to Defence Forces. It is, therefore, desirable that maximum eligible boys from all parts of our State compete to get into this institution.

It is submitted that as per Rule 3.22, dealing with advertisement and publicity, issued by the Board of Governors, Ministry of Defence, the State Government is bestowed with the responsibility to give wide publicity to the Entrance Examination including publication of Admission Notices in the Local Newspapers and issue the posters and handbills at their cost. Therefore, May I also request you to advise the Director, Public Relations and Director, All India Radio, Shimla to notify the schedule of admission to Sainik School Sujanpur Tira (HP) in leading Newspapers and State News Bulletins (both in English and Hindi) The required material including Admission Notice for publication in the Newspapers is enclosed.

I sincerely express my gratitude for the co-operation and patronage given by you every year because of which, a record number of applications were received from various parts of Himachal Pradesh for the previous Entrance Examination held in Jan 2013. Subject : **Sainik Schools Entrance Examination 2014-2015 Session.**

The Sainik Schools scheme came into existence in 1961 with the primary aim of preparing boys from socio-economically backward section of the Society for a career in the officer cadre of the Armed Forces and to remove regional imbalances in recruitment to the Armed Forces. At present, there are 24 Sainik Schools one in each State & two in Bihar Haryana and in Karnataka except Uttar Pradesh, Meghalaya, Arunachal Pradesh, Mizoram, Goa, Tripura and Sikkim. These schools are residential Public Schools and affiliated to the Central Board of Secondary Education to impart education upto Class XII under 10+2 patten of education.

2. Admission of boys in these schools is made every year in classes VI and IX based on an All India Entrance Examination conducted annually. The Entrance Examination for 2014-2015 for both classes VI & IX will be held on 05-01-2014 except Sainik School, Nagrova (J&K) for which separate Entrance Exam will be held by that school. In accordance with the decision of Board of Governors, boys in order to be eligible to take the exam for admission to classes VI and IX should be between the age of 10 to 11 years and 13 to 14 years on 1st July 2014 respectively. Necessary advertisement inviting application will be issued by the Sainik Schools individually or in-group in October 2013. The last date of receipt of application will be 7th December, 2013. 15% and 7 ½% seats are reserved for admission of boys belonging to Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes respectively. 25% seats are also reserved for the boys of service personnel including ex-servicemen.

3. The admission of boys in Sainik Schools is made strictly in accordance with merit in the Entrance Examination and subject to medical fitness. The Central and State Govts. have instituted liberal scholarship schemes for education in these schools. In order to have boys with high merit, it would be desirable to give wide publicity to the Entrance Exam so that a large number of candidates are attracted. While Sainik Schools will make all efforts in this behalf, you are requested to kindly direct your publicity department, District Collectors and Officials of the Social Welfare and Education Deptt. to give as much publicity as possible. I am instructing the Principals to contact you to supply necessary material, which might be required for publicity. All India Radio is also being requested to announce the Programme of this examination in their weekly bulletins for the Armed Forces. The Director General, National Cadet Corps too has been requested to issue instructions to all the Directorates of NCC for rendering assistance usual in the conduct of examination. The State Govt. may also like to advice the Principals on the adequacy of number of centers for the examination so as to attract the boys from backward regions of the States / Union Territories. State Govt. may also like to clearly indicate to the Principals of the Sainik Schools located in their area whether State / UT scholarship will be available for education to the Sainik Schools out-side the State / UT in case vacancies are offered to boys of their

INTRODUCTION

Sainik Schools are residential Schools for Boys only providing Public School Education with a Military Bias having All India system of examination and selection. The Schools are affiliated to Central Board of Secondary Education, New Delhi.

AIM

The aim of Sainik Schools is to prepare the boys academically, mentally and physically for entry into the National Defence Academy, Khadakwasla and other walks of life. A sound character, team spirit, dedication to purpose, a patriotic outlook and the desire to serve the country are the qualities which are promoted by these schools.

LOCATION

Sainik School Sujanpur Tira is located at a distance of 24 kms from Hamirpur at the Historical town SUJANPUR TIRA, famous for its Narbadeswar Temple which claims some of the good miniature paintings of Kangra Style.

FACILITIES

Well furnished Hostels to accommodate 525 boys, Mess, Library, Physics/Chemistry/Biology/Computer/Mathematics Laboratories, Smart Classrooms, Gymnasium, Swimming Pool, Tennis Court, Squash Court, a small infirmary, proximity to Govt. Hospital and extensive playgrounds, Music, Photography, Eco, Robotics, Gymnastics, IT and Literary Clubs, Cafeteria, Washing Services, Barber Services are also available.
