2. The All India Sainik Schools Entrance Examination for admission of boys to Class VI & IX in Sainik School, Sujanpur Tira (HP) for the session 2017-18 will be held on **15 Jan 2017 (Sunday)**. The sale of Prospectus-cum-Application form will start from **17 Oct 2016 to 18 Nov 2016**. The last date of receipt of filled-in applications at the school office will be **30 Nov 2016 (Wednesday)** by 1700 hrs. The Examination will be conducted at the following Centres:-

(b) Members: An officer representing Deputy Dir of Higher Education of the District in which the examination is held.

(c) Centre Superintendent: Principal of the school selected as venue for the examination will act as Centre Superintendent.

(d) In-charge Entrance Examination: Two teachers from Sainik School Sujampur Tira (HP) in each of the centres mentioned at Para 2. ibid.

(e) Invigilators: Invigilators from local Govt. Schools or NCC Unit may be appointed at the scale of one invigilator for every 25 candidates or part thereof.

5. It is requested that the Deputy Directors of Higher Education of Dharamshala, Mandi and Shimla and the Principals of the concerned schools, where the examination is being held, may please be directed to be members of the Board. THEIR NAMES, ADDRESSES AND CONTACT NUMBERS MAY PLEASE BE FORWARDED TO THIS SCHOOL AT THE EARLIEST ON TOP PRIORITY. The officers of Board so detailed may please be instructed to ensure their presence at the respective centres atleast one and a half hour before the commencement of the examination.

6. Test booklets will be provided by this School through its representatives who will report to the Chairman a day before the commencement of the examination with sealed Question Papers. On completion of the examination, test booklets (used/unused) will be duly packed and sealed in presence of the representative and handed over to School Rep for onward submission to Principal, Sainik School Sujampur Tira (HP).

7. It is also requested that the necessary instructions to above mentioned schools, where the venue is fixed (except Sainik School Sujampur Tira) may kindly be given to provide necessary administrative support. The Heads of the Institutions may be also instructed to provide well lit accommodation, preferably a hall so that all candidates (Approx 300) of that centre can be accommodated at one place with suitable furniture, Drinking water, toilet facility etc.

8. It is further requested that the Director of Higher Education, the Deputy Directors of Higher Education and Distt Primary Education Officers of all the districts may be asked to accord wide publicity among the Primary, Middle and High Schools under their jurisdiction about the Entrance Examination for admission to this prestigious institution. The information may also be disseminated through all Govt. Departments to ensure that all the eligible candidates, even from the remotest areas including Scheduled Caste and Scheduled Tribe categories get to know about this prestigious institution doing yeomen service for the State of HP and Defence of the country by sending maximum number of cadets to Defence Forces. It is, therefore, desirable that maximum eligible boys from all parts of our State compete to get into this institution.

### ADVERTISEMENT AND PUBLICITY


3.22 The State Government will be approached for wide publicity to the Entrance Examination, at their cost, in the local newspaper and by means of posters and hand-bills. The Director All India Radio will be approached for at least a couple of announcements in regional languages and the Director TV for publicity through interviews and documentary films highlighting the activities of the school. The advertisements should indicate the aim and curriculum, the date of the Entrance Examination, the number of vacancies, age limits, school fees and full details of the scholarship schemes of the State Government, the Ministry of Defence, the Ministry of Education and the Ministry of Home Affairs. It should indicate the last date fixed for receipt of applications (which should be at least one month before the date of examination) the sources from where application forms, prospectus and model questions can be obtained and the cost thereof. Application forms from general candidates should be accompanied by a registration fee of Rs. 50/- (Rs. 25 for candidates belonging to SC/ST). The Registration fee will not be refundable. The State Govt. should also be requested to bring out an attractive brochure in the regional language in consultation with the Principal of the Sainik School. Such brochure should be distributed by the State Govt. to primary and middle schools and to other agencies. The school may also publish small advertisements in the newspapers, debiting the expenditure to the Entrance Examination account.



9. It is also intimated that as per Rule 3.22 of the Sainik Schools Society Rules & Regulations dealing with Advertisement and Publicity (copy enclosed as enclosure II for reference), the State Government is assigned the responsibility to give wide publicity to the Entrance Examination, at their cost in the local news paper and by means of posters and handbills.

10. It is, therefore, also requested that the Director, Public Relations and Director, All India Radio, Shimla be directed to notify the schedule of admission to Sainik School Sujampur Tira (HP) in leading Newspapers and State News Bulletins (both in English and Hindi). The required material including Admission Notice for publication in the Newspapers is enclosed.

11. It is requested that priority be accorded to follow up the necessary actions in order to publicise the details of the Entrance Examination. It will be highly appreciated if the copy of your directions issued on the subject to all concerned is endorsed to this School for our record.

Note :-

i) The above dates are to be strictly adhered to. No extension of date will be granted.

ii) 'Surplus' means qualified candidates who cannot be admitted in the school of domicile, being low in merit and 'deficient' means lack of qualified candidates to fill in the available vacancies in each category. The deficient schools would fill in their vacancies based on combined merit list prepared from the surplus candidates willing for admission in that school in each category available from all schools.

2. The Entrance Examination will be held for admission to class VI & IX. Boys who are between the age of 10 to 11 years and 13 to 14 years respectively on 1<sup>st</sup> July of the year in which admission is sought are eligible to take the Entrance Examination. For admission to Class IX, the boys should be studying in Class VIII in a recognised school. Admission will be made strictly in order of merit only in classes VI and IX. In case the Entrance Examination cannot be conducted in any State/UT on account of administrative problem, a separate order will be issued to conduct another Entrance Examination on a date fixed by the Honorary Secretary.

3. The Registration charge will be included in the selling price of the prospectus-cum-application forms at the following rates:-

Previous year question papers can be obtained from the Principal on payment as prescribed by the Sainik Schools Society. It may, however, be made clear to the candidates that modification in the form and contents of the questions for class VI cannot be ruled out. All Principals are requested to send a specimen copy of the prospectus and application form to the Society as soon as the same is published in the newspapers.

4. In case boys who are qualified but low in merit in schools of their domicile and whose parents are willing to admit their wards in other Sainik Schools, will be required to give an undertaking that "they are willing to admit their sons/wards as full paying (fees) cadets in other Sainik Schools of their choice and under any circumstances will not seek inter-school transfer till the end of completion of studies of their wards in the Sainik School once they are selected/admitted". They will be allowed to identify/indicate any three Sainik School of their choice/preference as first, second and third in order of their choice. This clause will be included in the prospectus and the application form accordingly.

5. The intake into class IX will be so regulated that after passing class X, when the students of class IX this year reach class XI and XII, the number of sections in classes XI and XII need not be increased at any rate from what exists in the school at present. Similarly, the authorised strength of the school should not be exceeded. Category wise number of vacancies in class VI and IX available in the school may be determined and intimated to the Society by 31<sup>st</sup> October 2016. The number of vacancies may also clearly be indicated in the prospectus as well as in the advertisement.

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6. Wide publicity may be given about this examination through Akashvani, Doordarshan and by means of advertisements in the leading newspapers, both in Hindi & English as well as by posters and handbills and by any other means suited to the local conditions. State Directors/Directorates of Publicity may be contacted for having press handouts issued. The reservations of seats for SC/ST boys and the availability of scholarships from various sources may be explained properly. Each school will be responsible for making its own advertisement arrangements indicating that the school does not patronise any coaching institutes/agent and the admissions will be strictly in accordance with the merit and medical fitness of candidates in the Entrance Examination. The schools are instructed to sell Application Forms through internet also with the condition that parent would deposit registration fees in the form of Demand Draft alongwith completed form.

7. The school will make its own arrangements for the conduct of the Entrance Examination. The responsibility for publicity and the conduct of the examination in respect of the following States and the Union Territories where Sainik Schools are not established will be that of the schools indicated against each:

9. Medium of Examination for both the above examinations will be English, Hindi or any other recognized official language. The question papers for Class VI will continue to be set in English and all the recognised official languages. But question papers for class IX will be set in English only. No separate answer sheets are required for both Class VI and IX as ample space for answers is provided in question papers itself.

10. The minimum qualifying marks for general category candidates, as well as children of Defence Services Personnel and ex-servicemen will be 25% in each subject with 40% in aggregate unless these qualifying standards are revised or amended by issue of written directions by the Honorary Secretary. In the case of Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes candidates, minimum qualifying standards are not required and they will be admitted on the basis of inter-se merit at the Entrance Examination/interview within these categories. In case a SC/ST candidate comes in the general merit on his own, he would be admitted against general seat and will not be adjusted against the reserved share of SC/ST seats.

11. In addition to 300 marks prescribed for Written Examination for class VI and 450 marks for class IX, 50 marks for both VI & IX classes would be set apart for interview. The merit list for admission to the Sainik School would be compiled on the basis of total marks. In case there is a tie with regard to overall marks, the marks for mathematics would be considered. In case there is a tie here also the marks for English for class IX and Intelligence Test for class VI will be considered and thereafter the marks for General Science for class IX and Language for class VI. In case there is a tie there also the boy younger in age will be selected. It will not be necessary for a boy to qualify separately in the interview and marks obtained in the written test and interview together will determine his position in the final merit list.

12. It should be made clear in the prospectus as well as in the newspapers while declaring the final results that detailed marks list can be supplied only to the parent / legal guardian of the candidates on payment of Rs.100/- through crossed Postal Order / DD in favour of the School concerned.

13. **Reservation**

- a) 15% of the total seats are reserved for Scheduled Castes and 7½% seats for Scheduled Tribes.
- b) Out of the remaining seats, 67% of the seats will be reserved for boys from the State in which the Sainik School is located. Balance 33% left over of seats will be thrown open to boys from other States and Union Territories and home State in order of merit.
- c) 25% seats are reserved for children of service personnel including Ex-servicemen.

14. The Principals will take up the matter of fixation of centers with the State Govt. The State Government and NCC Dte. will separately be addressed by them to provide necessary assistance for the conduct of the Entrance Examination.

15. It should be noted that the interview and medical examination in respect of the candidates are completed on the same day, so that the candidates and guardians are not inconvenienced. The school will not be responsible for any delay in receiving interview/medical examination notice/letters by the cadets, including postal delay. The cadet who intends to appear in the interview/medical examination other than the date mentioned in the notice/letter will not be allowed to appear in the interview/ medical examination.

16. Your attention is invited to the contents of the paper on reforms in Entrance Examination systems, Sainik School, which was circulated vide our letter No. 17(1)/85/SSC dated 6-4-85. The directions given therein will strictly be complied with.

17. Staff children seeking admission to class VI and IX as day scholars will also appear in the Entrance Examination. Their admission will be carried out subject to their qualifying in the Entrance Examination and in accordance with the existing Rules and Regulations on the subject.

18. Demand for question paper(s) is required to be forwarded by the Principals to Sainik School Society by 30<sup>th</sup> November, 2016.

19. The Principals are directed to indicate all the above terms and conditions in the prospectus for All India Entrance Examination 2017-2018 session and send the compliance report with a copy of the prospectus-cum-application form to the Sainik Schools Society, immediately.

Subject: Sainik Schools Entrance Examination 2017-2018 Session

The Sainik Schools scheme came into existence in 1961 with the primary aim of preparing boys from socio-economically backward section of the Society for a career in the officer cadre of the Armed Forces and to remove regional imbalances in recruitment to the Armed Forces. At present, there are 25 Sainik Schools one each in 17 States & two in Bihar, Haryana, Karnataka and Andhra Pradesh (except in Uttar Pradesh, Telangana, Meghalaya, Arunachal Pradesh, Mizoram, Goa, Tripura and Sikkim). These schools are residential Public Schools and affiliated to the Central Board of Secondary Education to impart education upto Class XII under 10+2 pattern of education.

2. Admission of boys in these schools is made every year in classes VI and IX based on an All India Entrance Examination conducted annually. The Entrance Examination for 2017-2018 for both classes VI & IX will be held on 08-01-2017 except Sainik School, Nagrota (J&K) for which separate Entrance Exam will be held by that school. In accordance with the decision of Board of Governors, boys in order to be eligible to take the exam for admission to classes VI and IX should be between the age of 10 to 11 years and 13 to 14 years on 1st July 2017 respectively. Necessary advertisement inviting application will be issued by the Sainik Schools individually in October 2016. The last date of receipt of application will be 30<sup>th</sup> November, 2016. 15% and 7 ½% seats are reserved for admission of boys belonging to Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes respectively. 25% seats are also reserved for the boys of service personnel including ex-servicemen.

3. The admission of boys in Sainik Schools is made strictly in accordance with merit in the Entrance Examination and subject to medical fitness. The Central and State Govts. have instituted liberal scholarship schemes for education in these schools. In order to have boys with high merit, it would be desirable to give wide publicity to the Entrance Exam so that a large number of candidates are attracted. While Sainik Schools will make all efforts in this behalf, you are requested to kindly direct your publicity department, District Collectors and Officials of the Social Welfare and Education Deptt. to give as much publicity as possible.
