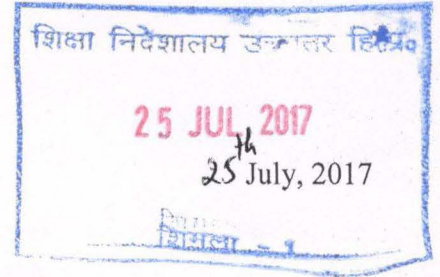

## Suggestive NSS Action Plan for celebrating Swachh Bharat Pakhwada (01-15 August, 2017)

The following activities are proposed to be organized from 1<sup>st</sup> to 15<sup>th</sup> August, 2017 to celebrate the Swachh Bharat Pakhwada in a befitting manner:

**State/Distt. Level:** Local Administration, Health Authorities may be approached to plan some collaborative cleanliness drives with locally available NSS Units .

**University Level :** Workshops and seminars on Swachhta should be organized at the University level to celebrate the **International Youth Day on 12<sup>th</sup> August, 2017.**

**NSS UNITS:** A mass anti-polythene campaign should be organized by all the NSS Units in market places, malls, institution campuses and adopted villages. Slogan writings and debates on swachhta should be organized . A series of lectures on Swachhta should be organized in the adopted villages/slums by the NSS Units with the help of local health department.

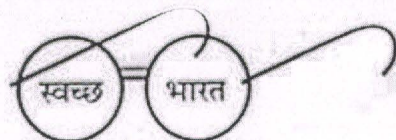
**NSS VOLUNTEERS:** All the NSS Volunteers should take a **Swachhta pledge (Copy enclosed)** to keep their surroundings clean to mark the occasion. The pledge ceremony should be followed by the rally in the cities to create awareness about cleanliness among the masses. A mass cleanliness drive should be organized in the campuses where all the locations like libraries, toilets, classrooms, labs etc, to be cleaned by the volunteers. NSS Volunteers should create awareness among the masses about the healthy habits like washing their hands before and after taking the meal, after the use of toilets, etc.

**ADOPTED VILLAGES :** A mass cleanliness drive should be organized in the adopted villages involving the villagers. The villagers of the adopted villages/ slums to be motivated by the volunteers to construct toilets in their houses and de-motivate them for open defecation. With the help of Gram Panchayats, the pond in the villages should be de-silted and cleaned, the wells of the villages should be cleaned and disinfected with the help of health department.
