Subject:- Regarding Swine Flu Influenza-A(H1N1).

In view of the recent increase in the reported cases of Swine Flu in Himachal Pradesh, you are requested to direct the Principals of all the Colleges and Headmasters and BPEO's schools, that any child having symptom of Influenza like illness (i.e. cough, cold, fever and sneezing etc.) may be directed to consult the nearest Doctor and also he/she may be kept in home isolation for at least 7 days & leave for that period may be granted without Medical Certificate. Moreover the guidelines being circulated for prevention of Swine Flu Influenza-A(H1N1) through newspaper and audio/ visual media be observed.
