I am directed to refer to the subject cited above and to  
say that a large number of drinking water samples are required to be collected in district  
laboratories and sub-divisional laboratories during monsoon season and pre-monsoon  
season, which is not being done properly due to shortage of manpower on our strength in  
these laboratories. The Joint Secretary to the Government of India, Ministry of Drinking  
Water and Sanitation, New Delhi vide his DO letter No.11019/1/2016-WQ, dated  
28/06/2016 (copy enclosed) has therefore suggested to consider testing water samples by  
engaging the local final year **Bachelor of Science-Chemistry(B.Sc.)/Master of Science-  
Chemistry(M.Sc.)** students for a couple of months without any financial implications  
except the recurring cost for testing the samples. This would be mutually beneficial as  
the students would gain in knowledge and exposure and the manpower shortage can also  
be addressed temporarily.

You are, therefore, requested to consider the proposal to  
undertake the testing of water samples in I&PH Laboratories by local students of final  
year **Bachelor of Science-Chemistry(B.Sc.)/Master of Science-Chemistry(M.Sc.)**  
which would necessarily give knowledge and exposure to the students. This may be  
adopted as a continuous exercise if Education Department consented so and a district can  
be adopted as a pilot to start with.




As you are aware, during monsoon and pre-monsoon seasons, a large number of Drinking Water samples are required to be collected in district laboratories and sub-divisional laboratories. One of the biggest impediment is shortage of manpower. Since adequate man power is not available to test all the water samples in these laboratories, the State Government may consider testing water samples by engaging the local final year Bachelor of Science-Chemistry (B.Sc) / Master of Science-Chemistry (M.Sc) students for a couple of months without any financial implications except the recurring cost for testing the samples. This would be mutually beneficial as the students would gain in knowledge and exposure and the manpower shortage also can be addressed to temporarily.


