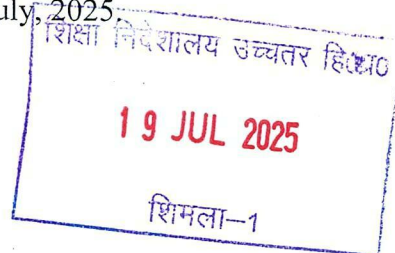

First Project Steering Committee Meeting

GSDP-NITI Project on support for SDG Localisation in the states of Himachal Pradesh, Meghalaya and Madhya Pradesh 30th April 2025 (Wednesday)

A virtual meeting was held on 30.04.2025 under the chairmanship of Shri Rajib Sen, PD (SDGs), NITI Aayog for the Project Steering Committee Constituted vide OM dated 09.05.2024 to discuss the progress of activities on the GSDP-NITI project for SDG localisation.

The meeting began with a welcome address by Shri Hemant Meena, Director, NITI Aayog followed by a round of introductions. Shri Rajib Sen, PD (SDGs), NITI Aayog delivered the opening address, setting the stage for the session and emphasising on the expectations of the NITI Aayog from this collaboration. A brief overview of the GSDP-NITI project was shared by Shri Gerald Guskowski, after which state-wise project updates and ideas for upcoming activities were presented for Himachal Pradesh, Meghalaya, and Madhya Pradesh. The session concluded with an open discussion and a vote of thanks by the GIZ team. The list of participants is placed at Annexure-1.

Key points of the discussion are as follows:

1. PD (SDGs), NITI Aayog encouraged GIZ and the states to work towards implementation and tangible outcomes, with special focus on SDG 3,4,5, and 13. Best practices regarding SDG implementation should be captured.
2. Creation and dissemination of SDG Awareness Material: PD (SDGs), NITI Aayog recommended that this activity be taken up on priority this year, preferably by June 2025.
3. Project Head, SDGCAC, Himachal Pradesh suggested that a finance mobilisation consultation/roundtable can be organized for better CSR utilisation and community engagement. He also suggested that bilateral exchange could also be facilitated between the GSDP states to encourage knowledge sharing.
4. Review of SIFs: PD (SDGs), NITI Aayog clarified that the SIFs should largely remain unchanged to maintain consistency in tracking SDG progress, with the review focusing on the enhancing the SIF by inclusion of relevant indicators and revision of indicators where saturation has already been achieved.
6. Development of SDG Dashboard of Madhya Pradesh: CEO, MPRNA highlighted that the dashboard would complement the CM Pragati Dashboard. Director (SDGs), NITI Aayog suggested that a district ranking could be included in the dashboard features.

7. Knowledge exchange with other States: PD (SDGs), NITI Aayog suggested that small thematic workshops may be planned around different topics such as financing to ensure active exchange between relevant stakeholders. It was suggested that the multilateral knowledge exchange with Haryana SDGCAC can be facilitated by NITI Aayog as a measure under the State Support Mission (SSM).

8. PD (SDGs) advised that in case any states are agreeable to take up a Voluntary Local Review, the contours of the framework to be adopted may be discussed with NITI before embarking on the activity.

9. Director (SDGs), NITI Aayog suggested that a comprehensive project plan with detailed timelines be prepared for each activity under the GSDP-NITI project.

Action Points emerged from the discussion are given as under:

1. Creation and dissemination of SDG awareness material.

2. Documentation of best practices in SDG implementation at district and block level.

[Action: GIZ, All states]

3. Knowledge exchange workshop on priority themes with states/UTs. Some workshop can be organised under SSM, NITI Aayog.

[Action: GIZ, NITI]

4. Development of comprehensive project plan with detailed timelines for each activity under the GSDP-NITI project.
