

ou are aware that "National War Memorial" near India Gate, New Delhi and "National Police Memorial" in Chanakyapuri area, New Delhi have been established to commemorate the sacrifices of our brave soldiers who laid down their lives for the nation post-Independence. The National War Memorial pay tributes to soldiers who laid down their lives defending the nation during the India-China war in 1962, Indo-Pak wars in 1947, 1965 and 1971, Indian Peace Keeping Force Operations in Sri Lanka and in the Kargil conflict of 1999. This Memorial has been constructed on the initiative of our Hon'ble Prime Minister, who for the first time after Independence thought about the construction of a Memorial where we can commemorate the sacrifices of our soldiers. Similarly, the National Police Memorial commemorates the police personnel from the Central and State Police forces in India who died in the line of duty fighting against terrorism, militancy and insurgency.

- These Memorials are a valuable source of inspiration for our future generations. It is said that lessons that are learnt early in life stay etched forever. So it would be a good initiative if we encourage more and more students from schools/colleges to visit these Memorials so that they could appreciate the hardships and sacrifices of our soldiers who fight to protect and safeguard the sovereignty and integrity of our country. Further, it will instill a sense of patriotism and motivate young Indians to join the Armed Forces.
- In view of this, it is suggested that the Ministry of HRD instruct all 3. schools/colleges/educational institutions, under their administrative control that visit to these two Memorials be a part of the "official study tours" for their students visiting Delhi, so that they gain knowledge about the contributions of our Armed Forces.
- I would be grateful if you could kindly get this suggestion considered 4. appropriately in your Ministry on priority.
