About 2050 winners will receive a certificate signed by Director, NCERT and copy of the 'Exam Warrior' written by Hon'ble Prime Minister.

The students, parents and teachers are required to frame their questions to be addressed to the Hon'ble Prime Minister. Selected questions shortlisted by NCERT may features in the programme. The participants who asked questions in the previous editions of Pariksha Pe Charcha are invited by Media Channel to appear in their programmes. Along the same lines this year chosen few may get an opportunity to interact with the media.

You are directed to upload instructions along with annexure –I & II on Pariksha Pe Charcha on your official website and issue instructions to all the schools under your jurisdiction to appoint school coordinator to give boost to the participation of students, teachers and parents in Pariksha Pe Charcha Programme and to give wide publicity to it through their official website and display of flex at prominent place in all the schools to ensure maximum registration of students by all schools. Institutional Heads may use whatsapp groups to disseminate the event along with their preparations for the event. Computer / IT Lab can be utilized for participation. Teacher's mobile number (upto 10 students) can be used for OTP. To ensure good participation of parents SMC meetings may be held in each school at the earliest. Action on the part of schools may be completed before 20th December, 2022. School could make their own posters, creatives, videos etc. and post accordingly. I. Themes for Students

1. Know your freedom fighters (हमारी आज़ादी के नायक)

What life stories have you heard about Freedom fighters of your State or Region? What inspirations do you draw from their life? How do you want to serve your nation?

2. Our culture is our pride (हमारी संस्कृति हमारा गर्व)

What is special about your state's culture? What elements of that culture make you feel proud of your country?

3. My book my inspiration (मेरी प्रिय किताब)

Which is a book that has shaped you greatly and why?

4. Save Environment for future generations (आने वाली पीढ़ियों के लिए पर्यावरण स्रका)

What are your ideas about sustainable development? What challenges, do you anticipate for our future generation due to climatic changes? What measures must we take to protect our environment? How can you contribute in the sustainable development as a student?

5. My life, my health (अच्छा स्वास्थ्य क्यों ज़रूरी है?)

Why is remaining healthy important? What do you do to remain in good health?

6. My startup dream (मेरा स्टार्टअप का सपना)

Entrepreneurship among students towards self-reliance for succeeding in life and at the same time contributing to the nation's economy and work culture is the need of the hour. What are your dreams about your own startup?

7. STEM education/ education without boundaries (सीमाओं के बिना शिक्षा)

NEP 2020 recommends flexibility in choice of subjects by the students. Students will have liberty to take subjects of their choice, choose their own path, and pursue a profession of their own choice. There is life beyond Science and Mathematics too. What do you think about this? What challenges do you see in this transformative recommendation? What are your suggestions?

How will you structure activities to ensure participation and learning of all the learners? What are your thoughts and opinion on 'peer learning'?

Though the entire education system needs to be transformed for providing skill education in our country, promotion of Vocational Education among secondary students is need of the hour. The reason being many students do not prefer to pursue academics/ higher education, rather they want to explore different avenues to go ahead in life. What are your thoughts on this?
