

Dear Madam,

To celebrate 75 years of Indian Independence, the various new events & initiatives have been planned by Ministry of Defence in collaboration with Ministry of Culture and Ministry of Education. The Republic day celebration live has been improvised to be more impactful all across the country as a part of "AZADI KA AMRIT MAHOTSAV". The prime objective of these activities is to select the best talent across the country and provide them an opportunity to be a part of Republic Day Celebrations 2022.

2. The highlights of various initiatives are as follows:

- i) **VANDE BHARATAM NRITYA UTSAV** : It is for the first time that dance groups which are going to be performed during Republic day 2022 are being chosen based on an All India competition. The journey of this event started on 17 Nov 2021 at district level with 323 groups & 3870 contestants participated initially. The Grand Finale was held on 19th Dec 2021 at Talkatora Stadium, New Delhi in the presence of Smt. Meenakshi Lekhi, Hon'ble Minister of Culture in which finally 480 contestants were selected who would perform during the parade.
- ii) **VEER GATHA** : This is a unique initiative conducted by Ministry of Education in collaboration with Ministry of Defence. The event was organised between 21st Oct 2021 to 20th Nov 2021. In this event projects were made across all over India by the students of class 3rd to Class 12th in form of Paintings, Poems, Essay and Multimedia presentation on the theme of Gallantry awardees. More than 8 Lakh entries were received from schools all over India, out of which 25 entries (Super 25) were selected by a National Level Committee constituted by Ministry of Education. The 25 winning entries will be felicitated by Ministry of Defence & Ministry of Education.
- iii) **SCROLL PAINTING** : Ministry of culture in collaboration with Ministry of Defence has organized 'Kala Kumbh', a initiative in which a series of scroll paintings with different artworks representing the tales of valour of unsung heroes of freedom struggle were painted by the artists from various geographical locations of India. Total 10 scrolls (75x4.5 mtr each) have been painted. 05 out of 10 selected scrolls were painted at Bhubaneswar during 11-15 Dec 2021 by appx. 250 artists and remaining 05 scrolls were painted at Chandigarh between 25 Dec to 02 Jan 2022. These scrolls are planned to be exhibited along Rajpath as part of celebrations of Republic Day 2022

(iv) **Drone Show:** Another First, a sparkling Drone show having fleet of around 1000 indigenously developed drones to dazzle the sky will be conducted by a startup of IIT Delhi Botlab Dynamics. It is a glaring jewel to Make in India drive undertaken by Hon'ble Prime Minister of India under Atmanirbhar Bharat. The same will be displayed during Beating the retreat ceremony on 29 th January 2022..

(v) **Inviting citizen registrations for watching live streaming of Republic Day Parade and Beating Retreat Ceremony 2022**

Keeping in view the recent surge in COVID Cases MoD has taken initiative to invite the citizen for watching the live streaming of Republic Day and Beating the Retreat Ceremony and to show their solidarity to the Republic of India.

Ministry of Defence has developed a website having url: www.indianrdc.mod.gov.in as well as You Tube channel, "Indian RDC" to host the events virtually. For the registration, a Web Page has been designed by MyGov wherein the user can register themselves along with their family members for watching the online streaming of Republic Day and Beating the Retreat Ceremony 2022 on mygov website. The registration will be through OTP based authentication through Mobile. A digital certificate will be jointly issued by MoD and MyGov to the user upon successful registration for watching the events online. The registration will enable the users to get the live-stream link for the RDC Parade along with various updates on Republic Day activities on their registered Mobile No.

After the closure of events, an online poll will be started on MyGov for selection of best contingents and activities performed during the Republic Day Parade and Beating the Retreat on the basis of public votes. This poll would be made available to only those users who register themselves to watch the live streaming of RDC and BRC 2022. The url for the same is <https://www.mygov.in/rd2022>.
