This is with reference to the Addl. Chief Secretary (AR), Govt. of HP letter No. Per(AR)A(3)-1/2018 dated 05th July, 2022 on the subject cited above and in continuation to this office letter of even No. dated 07.12.2018 vide which directed to implementation of Section 4(1)(a) of RTI Act, 2005.

In this connection, you are again directed to implement the Section 4(1)(a) of RTI Act, 2005, which refers Maintenance of records etc., for ready reference Section 4(1)(a) of RTI Act, 2005, is reproduced as herein below:

“ 4(1) (a)- Every Public Authority shall maintain all its records duly catalogued and indexed in a manner and the form which facilitates the Right to Information under this Act and ensure that all records that are appropriate to be computerised are, within a reasonable time and subject to availability of resources, computerised and connected through a network all over the country on different systems so that access to such records is facilitated.”

Therefore, you are again directed to implement the Section 4(1)(a) of RTI Act, 2005 and also maintained the records of your offices/institutions as well as the institutions under your control and send the status report regarding Section 4(1)(a) of RTI Act, 2005 to the undersigned through email on RTI Cell email id rtibr@rediffmail.com within two days positively, so that the information could be submitted to the Govt. accordingly.



Madam/Sir,

I am directed to refer to this office letters bearing No. Per(AR)A(3)-1/2008 dated 7th May 2008, Per(AR)A(8)1/2011 dated 29th March, 2011, Per(AR)A(8)2/2014 dated 17-10-2014, Per(AR)A(8)-1/2014 dated 25-04-2016 and Per(AR)F(7)-2/98-Vol-II dated 29-11-2017 on the subject cited above and to say that the Status specific regarding implementation of Section 4(1)(a) of RTI Act, 2005 is required to be supplied to the HHC HP.

The section 4(1)(a) of the Act ibid provides that all public authorities shall maintain all its record duly catalogued and indexed. Record Management in accordance with this provision is an important step to enable the Public Authorities to furnish information sought under the Act. The Clause also requires the Public Authorities to have its records computerized and connected through a network all over the Country. The public authorities were expected to complete the requirements of this clause within reasonable time and subject to availability of resources.

This department has issued direction /instructions from time to time to comply with the above referred requirement of the Act. For the purpose the Public Record Act, 2006 has been enacted to regulate the management, administration and presentation of the public Record of the State Government, Public Sector undertakings, Statutory Bodies and Corporations, Commissions and Committees constituted by the State Govt. Moreover, the provisions 19.1 to 19.9 Chapter XIX of H.P. Office Manual, 3rd Edition, 2011 also provides the mechanism to maintain the record of the Govt.


