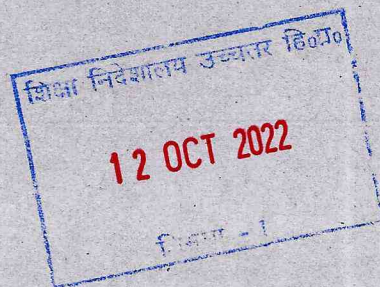

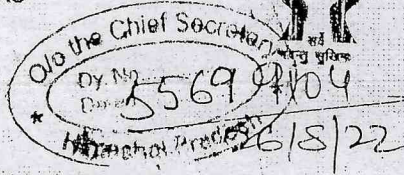

Dear Sir,

We are writing this letter to request you to use short films which has been prepared for NHRC for sensitization and creating awareness on various issues pertaining to human rights.

The National Human Rights Commission established under the Protection of Human Rights Act, 1973, has the statutory responsibility for better protection and promotion of human rights and matter connected therewith, *inter alia* to spread human rights literacy among various sections of the Society and to promote awareness of the safeguards available for the protection of these rights through publication, media, seminars, and other available means.

The Commission, had introduced the Short Film Award Scheme in 2015 to encourage and acknowledge cinematic and creative effects of the Indian citizen, towards the promotion and protection of human rights.

These are either in Hindi or any other Indian languages with sub-titles English, having duration of 3 to 10 minutes. Such short films under different categories like Bonded Labour, Child Rights, Women's Rights, Right to Education, Right to Life, Liberty & Personal Security, Right to Health, Rights of Sex Workers, Environmental Rights, Rights of people with special needs, etc., are available and the list is enclosed.

These films are available on the NHRC website (www.nhrc.nic.in) under the Media tab of "NHRC award winning short films".

It is requested that this information may be circulated among your subordinate offices and different organizations and these films may be considered for screening during seminars, conferences and workshops. These efforts may help in increasing awareness and sensitizing masses on human rights issues.
