

Reference D.O. No. 1(1)/1/2012/D(Cer)/73/Def Secy/21 dated September 07th, 2021 regarding the project on Gallantry Award Winners to honour their acts of bravery and sacrifice. Through this project, school students are to be motivated to do project work and other enrichment activities based on the life of gallantry award winners.

- 2. Accordingly, the MoE-MoD Veer Gatha Project has been launched from 21st October 2021 till 20th November 2021 for all schools in all states and Union Territories as well as all schools affiliated to CBSE. During this period schools will conduct activities at their level and selected entries will be submitted on Veer Gatha portal at CBSE website https://cbseit.in/cbse/2021/veer/index.aspx and MyGov platform https://inpovateIndia.mygov.in/veer-gatha-project/ from 1st November 2021 till 30th November 2021.
- 3. As proposed by the Ministry of Defence and as per the concept note on Veer Gatha Project, MoD will organize virtual and face-to-face awareness programmes / sessions of one hour duration for schools across the country through the field organisations or Army / Navy / Airforce units located at different parts of the country. During these interactive sessions, queries of students will be answered and short videos / PPTs / Documentaries / Brochures and various other resource material on the life of gallantry award winners will be shared with students.
- 4. Communications in this regard have been sent by CBSE on 12th October 2021 and 21st October 2021 to Ministry of Defence for sharing a list of Nodal persons from each Army cantonment, Naval and Air Force Base and other field units with CBSE, States and Union Territories who would coordinate for the Orientation Programs.
- 5. Orientation Programmes for schools and students will encourage their participation in the project from across the country and it will spread the message of bravery and sacrifice of gallantry award winners among students.

As you are aware that Ministry of Defence (MoD) maintains a dedicated website www.gallantryawards.gov.in to honour the acts of bravery and sacrifice of the officers/personnel of the Armed Forces, other lawfully constituted forces and civilians. These gallantry awards are announced twice in a year – first on the occasion of the Republic Day and then on the occasion of the Independence Day. The website has been redesigned recently with several additional features and has become quite popular among the masses.

- 2. In order to further disseminate the details of the bravery acts and the life stories of these brace-hearts among the students, it is proposed that school students should be given a project on our gallantry award winners. As part of this project, the students can frame different projects on these gallantry award winners and the best project is rewarded nationally by MoD and Ministry of Education on the occasion of 26th January (Republic Day) and 15th August (Independence Day).
- 3. The first such activity should be done for the forthcoming Republic Day i.e. on 26th January, 2022. I shall be grateful if the details of the activities proposed to be undertaken be shared with MoD on priority basis.
