## Sub: Awareness Drive for the Save Soil Movement

- Population growth, and food and water scarcity could cause over 1 billion to migrate to other regions and countries by 2050.

Sadhguru, a world-renowned Mystic, Yogi and humanitarian is undertaking an arduous 100-day motorcycle journey from United Kingdom to India covering 30,000 kms across 26

countries in Europe, Central Asia & Middle East. This effort is to reach the message to 3.5 billion people across the world. He will be attending more than 50 events along the way with opinion makers, politicians, media persons, ecologists and influencers to highlight the issue.

Within a short span of time since the launch, the Save Soil movement is having a strong impact:

- Secured support and partnership of many organizations, such as UN Convention to Combat Desertification, UN Environmental Program, UN Framework Convention on Climate Change, Food and Agriculture Organization of the United Nations, World Economic Forum, World Food Program, many world-renowned influencers, corporates, and heads of several states.
- 6 Caribbean nations, Antigua and Barbuda, Dominica, St. Lucia, St. Kitts and Nevis, Guyana and Barbados have signed MoUs with Save Soil movement and pledged to initiate concrete action in their countries to reverse and halt soil degradation. 12 more countries are in the pipeline to do the same.
- 54 Commonwealth countries have come forward and pledged support to the Save Soil Movement.
