

Dear Chief Secretary,

National Recruitment Agency (NRA) has been set up by Government of India under the Department of Personnel & Training, Ministry of Personnel, Public Grievances & Pensions as an autonomous body for conducting Common Eligibility Test (CET) for the candidates for Group 'B' non-gazetted, Group 'B' gazetted posts, which are exempted from consultation with UPSC, and Group 'C' posts in Government and equivalent posts through a computer based online mode. This test will be conducted for each of the three levels i.e. graduate level, higher secondary level (12th pass) and matriculation level (10th pass). Initially it is proposed to hold the CET for candidates for those non-technical posts for which recruitment is carried out by Staff Selection Commission (SSC), Railway Recruitment Board (RRB) and by the Institute of Banking Personnel Selection (IBPS).

2. The CET is aimed at providing a common Tier-1 test platform to all the candidates for multiple recruitment bodies beginning with above three. The candidate will thus appear in one test instead of taking multiple Tier-1 examinations conducted by different recruitment bodies. Moreover, one of the principal objectives is to conduct the CETs in rural areas and especially in all the aspirational districts (117) as identified by NITI Aayog. This will help in providing access to our youth by conducting examination in large number of districts of our country. This will set a new standard of equity and inclusiveness in recruitments for various government bodies in future.

3. In view of the above, I request you to suitably direct the District Magistrates (DMs), especially of rural and aspirational districts, to provide support to NRA in identifying as well as facilitating establishment of test centers with associated IT infrastructure for conducting CET in online mode. Necessary security measures would also be required during the days of tests. Thus, Sr. SSPs/SPs may be instructed through Home Department of State/UT to provide necessary security measures especially for those areas where tests would be conducted for the first time.

4. The State Staff Selection Commissions (SSSCs), Subordinate Staff Selection Bodies (SSSBs) and other institutions like school/college examination bodies in the States may have conducted online examinations earlier in rural/aspirational districts. They may be advised to provide the details to the district administration as well as to NRA for considering them to be included as test centers for online CET.

5. Shri Sanjeeb Kumar Mishra, IAS has joined as Secretary-cum-Controller of Examinations, NRA in the 1st week of June, 2021. He has been advised to correspond with the above institutions and with State Government Senior Officers for the above purpose.
