Prosecution sanctions against Public Servants u/s 19 of P.C.

Sir,

Subject: -

I am directed to refer to the subject cited above and to say that this department has issued instructions from time to time regarding grant of prosecution sanction, stipulated timelines to be followed while granting prosecution sanction and the format of sanction order. The last such instruction was circulated vide letter No. Home(Vig)B(15)-8/2018-Misc-RD&PR dated 26.11.2019(this letter alongwith earlier references is available on the Vigilance link of Home Department in the official website of the State Government).

Previously the sanction u/s 19 of the PC Act, 1988 against a retried officer / official was not required to be accorded by the competent authority because such officer/ official ceased to be the public servant after retirement. Your kind attention is invited to section 19 (1)(a) and (b) of the Prevention of Corruption(Amendment) Act, 2018 which uses the words "who is employed, or as the case may be, was at the time of commission of the alleged offence employed." -Thus making the prosecution sanction of retired Govt. Officer(s)/ Official(s) mandatory.

However, instances have come to the notice of this Department where Administrative Departments are returning the request of this Department for granting Prosecution Sanction under section 19 of the PC Act citing the instructions of the Ministry of Personnel, Govt. of India issued vide letter No. 107/8/99-ADV.I dated 27-10-1999 with the contention that the cases for grant of Prosecution Sanction against retired officer(s) need not be referred as they ceased to be Public Servant after retirement and sanction is not required to be accorded, which is against the spirit of P.C. (amendment)Act, 2018.

It is, once again, brought to your kind notice that section 19 of the Prevention of Corruption Act has been amended with addition "or as the case may be was at the time of commission of the alleged offence employed." which included such person who has ceased to hold the public office on his retirement. Thus, in view of above, prosecution sanction is required in respect of any public servant who is to be prosecuted before the court of law for any offence under the PC Act irrespective of the fact that public servant is still in service or has retired.

You are, therefore, requested to kindly take further action accordingly and decide the cases of prosecution sanction(s) on top priority.
