To conduct RMSA Training of 9th and 10th class teachers for the year 2017.

Memo,

I have been directed to inform you that the Govt. has decided to conduct all the teacher training programmes in holidays. It is also to inform that Govt. of India has approved the training of 2174 Science and Maths teachers and 5010 Social Science, English ,Hindi Sanskrit, Yoga and computer Teachers of the State for 10 days. For this, KRPs have been trained at State level (List Attached in annexure A -1 and A-11) in association with NCERT faculty for five days.

The main focus of the training is on Pedagogical developments and latest Researches, Constructivist approach of lesson transaction, motivation, ICT & MIS Applications, Swyamsidham Competition based Test Module and action research in teaching learning process where teachers and students may indulge in identifying problems preparing hypothesis, collecting and interpreting data based on the observation and drawing out the conclusion.

Therefore, as per the direction of the State Govt, the training of teachers, teaching class 9th to class 10th will start from June as per the dates specified in **annexure** A for the academic session 2017-18.

All the Teachers teaching 9th and 10th classes of all the Districts are to attend the training as per the schedule. All the DIETs are to submit their final plan of action, venues and schedule as per the need analysis of the district to the office of undersigned. The General and Subject Specific schedules of the training are attached in annexure (B, B-1, B-II, and B-III).

It is further to reiterate that recently trained KRP's in association with KRP's trained during previous years at National and State Level would only be deputed as RP's for training programmes and the training to be conducted under the control and supervision of DIETs, as already discussed, and BRCC's be also associated while organising the training. The DIET's may have concurrent venues at different places centrally located for convenience of teachers.
