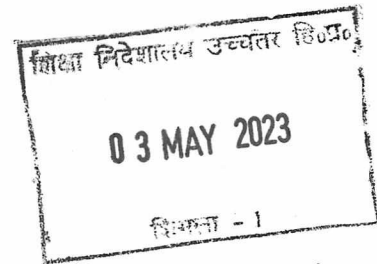

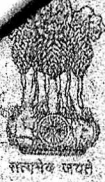

Dear Sir / Madam,

The idea of Ek Bharat Shreshtha Bharat which envisages a sustained and structured cultural connect among various States of India was mooted by Hon'ble Prime Minister. Under Ek Bharat Shreshtha Bharat, the Govt. of India has launched an initiative called 'Yuva Sangam' under which exposure visits of youth (college/ university students and other youth) are being organized between various states.

2. During their visits, the youth are given multi-dimensional exposure under five broad areas – Paryatan (Tourism), Parampara (Traditions), Pragati (Development), Prodyogik (Technology) and Paraspar Sampark (People-to-people connect). In addition to this, various interactions with industrial bodies like FICCI, CII, etc.; interactions at Raj Bhawan, CM office, interactions with MSMEs, startup entrepreneurs, artists, singers, sportspersons, musicians, SHGs, NGOs, etc. are also to be arranged as a part of the tour to enrich their overall experience.

3. After the huge success of Yuva Sangam Phase I, this Ministry in coordination with 7 Union Ministries has launched Yuva Sangam Phase II involving 20 higher education institutes (HEIs) in 23 states and UTs (list enclosed).

4. We would request for your kind cooperation to extend all the necessary support that the institutes may require from the state/ district administration to make the Yuva Sangam a huge success and realize the dream of Shreshtha Bharat as our country marches towards the Amrit Kaal.
