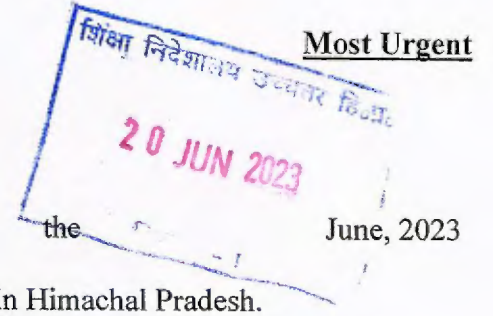

Dear Shri Saxena,

As you are well aware that the United Nations General Assembly in a resolution passed in December, 1987, proclaimed 26th June of each year as the "International Day against Drug Abuse & Illicit Trafficking" and thus, every year on 26th June, steps taken by the Government against drug abuse and illicit trafficking are highlighted, apart from spreading awareness on the subject. The very aim of this observance is to create awareness amongst the public regarding ill effects of Drug Menace.

2. The Government of India has also adopted a vision for a "DRUG FREE INDIA", which reiterates India's resolve to fight against the menace of drugs. In compliance of this, NCB proposes to observe "नशा मुक्त भारत पखवाड़ा" from 12th to 26th June, 2023, on a Pan-India basis.

3. It is of note that law enforcement agencies and other stakeholders have the responsibility to take preventive action as well as to spread awareness about the ill-effects of drug abuse among the general population. NCB has been strongly enforcing the fight against the supply side and equally shares the responsibility to spread awareness about the ill-effects of drug abuse in collaboration with Ministry of Social Justice & Empowerment among citizens at large and the youth in particular.

4. 26th June is a momentous occasion wherein a comprehensive analysis of the efforts made by all relevant stakeholders against drug menace may be taken up with a view to move forward with renewed vigour and energy. The Hon'ble Union Home Minister has also directed that mass awareness campaign against ill effects of drugs should be undertaken on National level through suitable platforms including educational institutes etc. Keeping in view the importance of this day, it is requested that various programs such as rallies, seminars, workshops, e-pledge campaigns etc. related to drug supply/demand/harm reduction may be organized and given wide publicity through media, including social media platforms, so that we may take a step closer in realizing the dream of "DRUG FREE INDIA".

5. In this regard, all Zonal Directors of NCB have also been directed to coordinate with the State Governments for effective implementation of these programs. You are requested to provide the necessary support to all Zonal/field units of NCB across the country.
