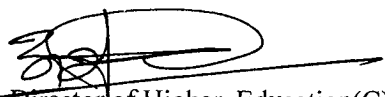
Subject: - Regarding National Voters Day (25th January, 2023).

Kindly treat it as most urgent and action in the matter may be taken on top-priority basis.

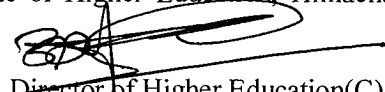

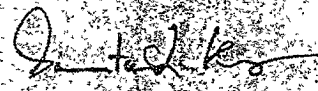

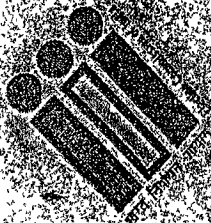
