Sir/ Madam,

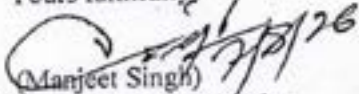
I am directed to refer to the subject cited above and to state that the proposal submitted by your University for approval of the fee structure for the Academic Session 2026-27 has been examined by the Government. Based on the recommendations of the Fee Structure Committee, the Government has been approved the fee structure in r/o Sri Sai University, Palampur for the Academic Session 2026-27, as detailed in Annexures 'A', 'B' and 'C', subject to the following terms and conditions:

1. The University shall not start any course without the approval of the Himachal Pradesh Private Educational Institutions Regulatory Commission.
2. The approval of the fee structure of new courses as well as existing courses for the Academic Session 2026-27 shall be subject to the condition that the same shall be applicable only to those courses which have already been approved by the Himachal Pradesh Private Educational Institutions Regulatory Commission.
3. If any course/degree/programme for which the fee has been approved is not recognized by the UGC/Regulatory Bodies, the fee for the same shall be deemed not to have been approved.
4. The fee structure approved for the courses for the year 2025-26 shall not be applicable for the year unless these courses are approved by the Himachal Pradesh Private Educational Institutions Regulatory Commission for continuation.
5. The University shall ensure engagement of faculty as per the norms fixed by the Regulatory Bodies, i.e. UGC, AICTE, BCI, MCI, etc., and shall comply with the UGC (Establishment and Maintenance of Standards in Private Universities Regulations), 2003, as amended from time to time.
6. The University shall comply with the "Mandatory Assessment and Accreditation of Higher Educational Institutions" Regulations, 2012, as amended from time to time, if any.

7. Copies of the annual accounts and balance sheet prepared under sub-section (4) of Sections 38 & 39 of the Act of the individual concerned shall be presented to the Himachal Pradesh Private Educational Institutions Regulatory Commission, Shimla, and to the Government through the Director of Higher Education, H.P., Shimla, positively by 31st August.
8. The University shall give details of the regular faculty, physical and academic infrastructure, and yearly academic calendar (such as vacations, admission dates, eligibility criteria, examination schedule, extracurricular activities, etc.) in the prospectus for the information of students, the general public, and the State Government, and a copy of the same shall be provided to the Himachal Pradesh Private Educational Institutions Regulatory Commission as well as to the Government through the Director of Higher Education, H.P., Shimla, well before the start of the next academic session. Further, the details of the entire faculty, including contractual/part-time faculty, along with their photographs, qualifications, and bio-data, should be available on the official website of the University in respect of those who are in position as on 31st August.
9. The infrastructure, viz. computers, laboratories, and other equipment, shall be provided as per the norms of the Regulatory Bodies and shall be available before the start of the respective course.
10. The tuition fee shall be charged annually in two equal instalments.
11. The University shall ensure that fees towards the building fund, infrastructure fund, development fund, etc. are not charged from the students, in compliance with the judgment passed in CWP Nos. 8789 & 8781 of 2014 – Business Institute of Management Studies V/s State of H.P. and ors. In case the Institutional Development Charges have been charged from the old students, it should be ensured that the same are adjusted against the tuition fee to be charged in future. In the case of final-year students, the same should be refunded.
12. The one-time Caution Money for the Hostel will be ₹5,000/- and for the University, it will be ₹10,000/-, which shall be refundable. The University shall ensure that the Caution Money refundable to the students is adjusted against the Tuition Fee. In the case of final-year students, the same should be refunded.
13. The University shall ensure that the fee as approved by the Government is charged from the students and that no other fee is charged under any other head of the University.
14. The University shall clearly categorize the fees for hostellers and non-hostellers, as the case may be, and indicate the details thereof as approved by the Government.
15. The University shall encourage and implement all the welfare schemes applicable to the staff as well as the students.
16. Ten per cent (10%) of the seats in all courses shall be reserved for Himachali Bonafide BPL/IRDP candidates in all Private Universities, and no tuition fee shall be charged from candidates admitted against such reserved seats.

17. The fee approved shall be applicable from the Academic Session 2026-27 for the new batch and will remain the same till the completion of the course. The old batches shall be charged as per the earlier approved fee structure till the completion of their courses.
18. As per the provisions of Section 8(a) of the Himachal Pradesh Private Educational Institutions (Regulatory Commission) Act, 2010, up to 1% (one per cent) of the fee, as assessed by the Regulatory Commission, is required to be credited to the fund established under the Act *ibid*. Charging such percentage of the total fee as may be assessed by the Regulatory Commission for the Academic Session 2025-26 is permissible under Section 8(a) of the Act *ibid*, subject to the final outcome of Civil Appeal No. 11290 of 2013, and the same shall be deposited with the HP PEIRC.
19. In case any deficiency is observed at a later stage or any fee in excess has been charged, appropriate action as per the Act/Rules shall be initiated against the University.

3. If any course/degree/programme for which the fee has been approved is not recognized by the UGC/Regulatory Bodies, the fee for the same shall be deemed not to have been approved.
4. The fee structure approved for the courses for the year 2025-26 shall not be applicable for the year unless these courses are approved by the Himachal Pradesh Private Educational Institutions Regulatory Commission for continuation.
5. The University shall ensure engagement of faculty as per the norms fixed by the Regulatory Bodies, i.e. UGC, AICTE, BCI, MCI, etc., and shall comply with the UGC (Establishment and Maintenance of Standards in Private Universities Regulations), 2003, as amended from time to time.
6. The University shall comply with the "Mandatory Assessment and Accreditation of Higher Educational Institutions" Regulations, 2012, as amended from time to time, if any.

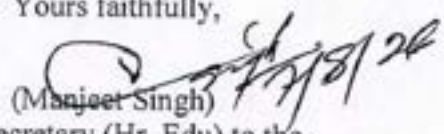

Final Fee Structure for the Academic Session 2026-27.

Sir/ Madam,

I am directed to refer to the subject cited above and to state that the proposal submitted by your University for approval of the fee structure for the Academic Session 2026-27 has been examined by the Government. Based on the recommendations of the Fee Structure Committee, the Government has been approved the fee structure in r/o Shoolini University of Biotechnology & Management Studies, Solan for the Academic Session 2026-27, as detailed in Annexures 'A', 'B' and 'C', subject to the following terms and conditions:

1. The University shall not start any course without the approval of the Himachal Pradesh Private Educational Institutions Regulatory Commission.
2. The approval of the fee structure of new courses as well as existing courses for the Academic Session 2026-27 shall be subject to the condition that the same shall be applicable only to those courses which have already been approved by the Himachal Pradesh Private Educational Institutions Regulatory Commission.
3. If any course/degree/programme for which the fee has been approved is not recognized by the UGC/Regulatory Bodies, the fee for the same shall be deemed not to have been approved.
4. The fee structure approved for the courses for the year 2025-26 shall not be applicable for the year unless these courses are approved by the Himachal Pradesh Private Educational Institutions Regulatory Commission for continuation.
5. The University shall ensure engagement of faculty as per the norms fixed by the Regulatory Bodies, i.e. UGC, AICTE, BCI, MCI, etc., and shall comply with the UGC (Establishment and Maintenance of Standards in Private Universities Regulations), 2003, as amended from time to time.
6. The University shall comply with the "Mandatory Assessment and Accreditation of Higher Educational Institutions" Regulations, 2012, as amended from time to time, if any.

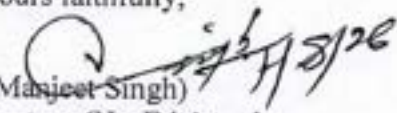

7. Copies of the annual accounts and balance sheet prepared under sub-section (4) of Sections 38 & 39 of the Act of the individual concerned shall be presented to the Himachal Pradesh Private Educational Institutions Regulatory Commission, Shimla, and to the Government through the Director of Higher Education, H.P., Shimla, positively by 31st August.
8. The University shall give details of the regular faculty, physical and academic infrastructure, and yearly academic calendar (such as vacations, admission dates, eligibility criteria, examination schedule, extracurricular activities, etc.) in the prospectus for the information of students, the general public, and the State Government, and a copy of the same shall be provided to the Himachal Pradesh Private Educational Institutions Regulatory Commission as well as to the Government through the Director of Higher Education, H.P., Shimla, well before the start of the next academic session. Further, the details of the entire faculty, including contractual/part-time faculty, along with their photographs, qualifications, and bio-data, should be available on the official website of the University in respect of those who are in position as on 31st August.
9. The infrastructure, viz. computers, laboratories, and other equipment, shall be provided as per the norms of the Regulatory Bodies and shall be available before the start of the respective course.
10. The tuition fee shall be charged annually in two equal instalments.
11. The University shall ensure that fees towards the building fund, infrastructure fund, development fund, etc. are not charged from the students, in compliance with the judgment passed in CWP Nos. 8789 & 8781 of 2014 – Business Institute of Management Studies V/s State of H.P. and ors. In case the Institutional Development Charges have been charged from the old students, it should be ensured that the same are adjusted against the tuition fee to be charged in future. In the case of final-year students, the same should be refunded.
12. The one-time Caution Money for the Hostel will be ₹5,000/- and for the University, it will be ₹10,000/-, which shall be refundable. The University shall ensure that the Caution Money refundable to the students is adjusted against the Tuition Fee. In the case of final-year students, the same should be refunded.
13. The University shall ensure that the fee as approved by the Government is charged from the students and that no other fee is charged under any other head of the University.
14. The University shall clearly categorize the fees for hostellers and non-hostellers, as the case may be, and indicate the details thereof as approved by the Government.
15. The University shall encourage and implement all the welfare schemes applicable to the staff as well as the students.
16. Ten per cent (10%) of the seats in all courses shall be reserved for Himachali Bonafide BPL/IRDP candidates in all Private Universities, and no tuition fee shall be charged from candidates admitted against such reserved seats.

17. The fee approved shall be applicable from the Academic Session 2026-27 for the new batch and will remain the same till the completion of the course. The old batches shall be charged as per the earlier approved fee structure till the completion of their courses.
18. As per the provisions of Section 8(a) of the Himachal Pradesh Private Educational Institutions (Regulatory Commission) Act, 2010, up to 1% (one per cent) of the fee, as assessed by the Regulatory Commission, is required to be credited to the fund established under the Act *ibid*. Charging such percentage of the total fee as may be assessed by the Regulatory Commission for the Academic Session 2025-26 is permissible under Section 8(a) of the Act *ibid*, subject to the final outcome of Civil Appeal No. 11290 of 2013, and the same shall be deposited with the HP PEIRC.
19. In case any deficiency is observed at a later stage or any fee in excess has been charged, appropriate action as per the Act/Rules shall be initiated against the University.

Subject: Final Fee Structure for the Academic Session 2026-27.

Sir/ Madam,

I am directed to refer to the subject cited above and to state that the proposal submitted by your University for approval of the fee structure for the Academic Session 2026-27 has been examined by the Government. Based on the recommendations of the Fee Structure Committee, the Government has been approved the fee structure in r/o Eternal University for the Academic Session 2026-27, as detailed in Annexures 'A', 'B' and 'C', subject to the following terms and conditions:

1. The University shall not start any course without the approval of the Himachal Pradesh Private Educational Institutions Regulatory Commission.
2. The approval of the fee structure of new courses as well as existing courses for the Academic Session 2026-27 shall be subject to the condition that the same shall be applicable only to those courses which have already been approved by the Himachal Pradesh Private Educational Institutions Regulatory Commission.
3. If any course/degree/programme for which the fee has been approved is not recognized by the UGC/Regulatory Bodies, the fee for the same shall be deemed not to have been approved.
4. The fee structure approved for the courses for the year 2025-26 shall not be applicable for the year unless these courses are approved by the Himachal Pradesh Private Educational Institutions Regulatory Commission for continuation.
5. The University shall ensure engagement of faculty as per the norms fixed by the Regulatory Bodies, i.e. UGC, AICTE, BCI, MCI, etc., and shall comply with the UGC (Establishment and Maintenance of Standards in Private Universities Regulations), 2003, as amended from time to time.
6. The University shall comply with the "Mandatory Assessment and Accreditation of Higher Educational Institutions" Regulations, 2012, as amended from time to time, if any.

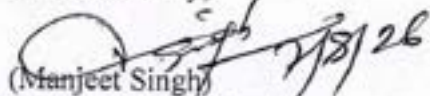

7. Copies of the annual accounts and balance sheet prepared under sub-section (4) of Sections 38 & 39 of the Act of the individual concerned shall be presented to the Himachal Pradesh Private Educational Institutions Regulatory Commission, Shimla, and to the Government through the Director of Higher Education, H.P., Shimla, positively by 31st August.
8. The University shall give details of the regular faculty, physical and academic infrastructure, and yearly academic calendar (such as vacations, admission dates, eligibility criteria, examination schedule, extracurricular activities, etc.) in the prospectus for the information of students, the general public, and the State Government, and a copy of the same shall be provided to the Himachal Pradesh Private Educational Institutions Regulatory Commission as well as to the Government through the Director of Higher Education, H.P., Shimla, well before the start of the next academic session. Further, the details of the entire faculty, including contractual/part-time faculty, along with their photographs, qualifications, and bio-data, should be available on the official website of the University in respect of those who are in position as on 31st August.
9. The infrastructure, viz. computers, laboratories, and other equipment, shall be provided as per the norms of the Regulatory Bodies and shall be available before the start of the respective course.
10. The tuition fee shall be charged annually in two equal instalments.
11. The University shall ensure that fees towards the building fund, infrastructure fund, development fund, etc. are not charged from the students, in compliance with the judgment passed in CWP Nos. 8789 & 8781 of 2014 – Business Institute of Management Studies V/s State of H.P. and ors. In case the Institutional Development Charges have been charged from the old students, it should be ensured that the same are adjusted against the tuition fee to be charged in future. In the case of final-year students, the same should be refunded.
12. The one-time Caution Money for the Hostel will be ₹5,000/- and for the University, it will be ₹10,000/-, which shall be refundable. The University shall ensure that the Caution Money refundable to the students is adjusted against the Tuition Fee. In the case of final-year students, the same should be refunded.
13. The University shall ensure that the fee as approved by the Government is charged from the students and that no other fee is charged under any other head of the University.
14. The University shall clearly categorize the fees for hostellers and non-hostellers, as the case may be, and indicate the details thereof as approved by the Government.
15. The University shall encourage and implement all the welfare schemes applicable to the staff as well as the students.
16. Ten per cent (10%) of the seats in all courses shall be reserved for Himachali Bonafide BPL/IRDP candidates in all Private Universities, and no tuition fee shall be charged from candidates admitted against such reserved seats.

17. The fee approved shall be applicable from the Academic Session 2026-27 for the new batch and will remain the same till the completion of the course. The old batches shall be charged as per the earlier approved fee structure till the completion of their courses.
18. As per the provisions of Section 8(a) of the Himachal Pradesh Private Educational Institutions (Regulatory Commission) Act, 2010, up to 1% (one per cent) of the fee, as assessed by the Regulatory Commission, is required to be credited to the fund established under the Act *ibid*. Charging such percentage of the total fee as may be assessed by the Regulatory Commission for the Academic Session 2025-26 is permissible under Section 8(a) of the Act *ibid*, subject to the final outcome of Civil Appeal No. 11290 of 2013, and the same shall be deposited with the HP PEIRC.
19. In case any deficiency is observed at a later stage or any fee in excess has been charged, appropriate action as per the Act/Rules shall be initiated against the University.
